1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, originally known as the Filipino Presidents Club of Guam,
4 became the interim between the inactivity of the Filipino Community of Guam (FCG)
5 to its resurrection. In 1985, the late Senator Ernesto Espaldon assumed the task of
6 revitalizing the Filipino Community of Guam. This was one of the prominent
7 accomplishments of the Filipino Presidents Club of Guam (FPCG); and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1996, the Filipino Presidents Club of Guam's Constitution and
9 By-laws was amended to reflect the updated name of Filipino-American Presidents
10 Club of Guam (FAPCG). The organization also established a signature project – the
11 annual Scholarship Program for the youth who is pursuing higher education after high
12 school. To date, Major Selmer Santos is a success story of this program; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam was chartered
14 with a purpose and objectives of fostering unity and closer relationship among members

1 for a common ideal and a vision for peace as a primary goal to bring about a vibrant
2 community, to assist the people of Guam and abroad in time of need by providing moral
3 and financial support, to provide socio-civic, spiritual and humanitarian support to all
4 members and the community and to participate in all activities and functions and to
5 generate revenues in accordance with the laws of the Territory of Guam and the United
6 States; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the FAPCG is composed of past and present presidents and vice
8 presidents of various Filipino-American ethnic and international organizations, whereas
9 sustaining members are open to any Filipino-American who is ready to subscribe to the
10 goals and objectives of the club but may not be elected to office. Executive officers are
11 elected every two years in the month of October and are inducted into Office in January
12 of the following year; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the club membership who are mostly leaders of the community and
14 the various Filipino organizations and clubs on island are the active contributors to the
15 civic-socio-cultural life on island. The past couple years have been very busy and
16 fruitful for the FAPCG such as: providing yearly donations to Eskwelahang Munti, a
17 school teaching Filipino culture, traditions, arts, music and history; providing
18 Scholarships and support to students at the University of Guam; donating to the Santa
19 Barbara Parish for its annual "Simbang Gabi" dawn Christmas Novena Mass; yearly
20 feedings at Kamalen Karidat and Guma San Jose; the annual celebration of the Santa
21 Nino fiesta and Santa Marian Kamalen; supports the Filipino Community of Guam
22 (FCG) by serving in various committees and assisting in numerous activities and events
23 of Filipino umbrella organization; and
