WHEREAS, in 2010, Sean began his motocross career in the U.S.; and he later went to Brazil, where he raced for two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, Sean started a motocross training business in Southern California, which is known as the motocross capital. The Sean Lipanovich Motocross School, also known as the SLMX School, is located in Riverside, California, and specializes in conducting motocross training for all ages and skill levels. The SLMX School also offers dirt bike rentals, inclusive packages, full time training, and accommodation; and the SLMX School trains around three hundred (300) to five hundred (500) riders per year; and

WHEREAS, Sean has also received numerous awards over the years, such as 1<sup>st</sup> place at the 2016 Pro Class World Vet Championship; Fastest Qualifying Privateer at the 2016 MXGP Glen Helen; 1<sup>st</sup> place at the 2017 Transworld Industry Cup; 1<sup>st</sup> place at the National Winter Olympic Super Cross School Boys Championship in the United States; and 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall at the Brazil Motocross Championships; and

WHEREAS, Sean was featured on the cover of the January 2018 issue of Dirt Bike Magazine, and is a Test Rider for Dirt Bike Magazine. He also appeared on the Lifetime Channel with the Little Women of LA: 54, EI, SLMX School Premier, and Brazilian Rapper, and in Duduzinho's music video - SLMX School Premier; and

WHEREAS, from 2015 to 2017, Sean returned to Guam and participated in the Smokin' Wheels Event, where he won the overall championship; and, each year, he conducts a Motocross Training Clinic for the youth on Guam; and

WHEREAS, in his spare time, Sean enjoys going to the beach with his family, exploring new countries, and learning about different cultures; and

WHEREAS, Sean went on to compete and represent the island of Guam throughout 2017 at the FIM Asia Motocross Championship Series, which consisted of eight (8) events, and was seen via global telecast in over 650 million households in six (6) continents on speed and sports channels, such as Fox Sports, Speed, ESPN, and Eurosports TV, and where champion riders from all over Asia (Japan, Thailand, Guam, Malaysia, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Mongolia, Indonesia, and Singapore) competed for the Championship Title; and

WHEREAS, all of Sean's hard work and commitment paid off when he travelled to Bangkok, Thailand to attend the FIM Asia General Assembly to receive the 2017 FIM Asia Motocross Championship award and title, making this a first time achievement in the motocross sport for Guam; now therefore, be it


