



1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, he got his start in the tourism industry back in 1980 working for
4 the Japan Travel Bureau within the Group Tour Division; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 1993 Mr. Hiyoshi handled the Versailles Palace Charter in
6 Paris, France that had an estimated four thousand in attendance and in 2002 he was
7 the General Manager for the Gold Coast Office in Australia; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 2005, Mr. Hiyoshi was the General Manager of the Auckland
9 office in New Zealand and in 2008 he became the Director of Japan Travel Bureau
10 World Vacations; and

11 **WHEREAS**, he became President of Lam Lam Tours and Transportation in
12 2010 and would eventually retire after eight years in 2018; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Hiyoshi’s exceptional leadership led to the upgrading of
2 Lam Lam’s fleet by adding an additional nineteen buses and upgrading to an
3 electronic bus cleaning and maintenance machine; and

4 **WHEREAS**, he believed in the advancement of his employees. He
5 emphasized heavily in constant training for employees, managers, and directors of
6 operation. Mr. Hiyoshi wanted to ensure that all employees were afforded the
7 opportunity to excel and move up; and

8 **WHEREAS**, he was an staunch advocate for tourism education with
9 involvement in Guam Community College’s On the Job Training, certifications for
10 mechanics, bus drivers, and tour guides together with the Department of Labor and
11 Agency of Human Resources (AHRD); ; and

12 **WHEREAS**, along with dedication to his job and contributions to the island,
13 he was part of the Japan Club of Guam where he served as Vice-Chairman and
14 Director of Education, Vice-Chairman of the Japanese School, Secretary for the
15 Japan Guam Travel Association, and member and Secretary for the Rotary Club of
16 Tumon Bay; and

17 **WHEREAS**, his professionalism and commitment to Lam Lam Tours and
18 Transportation has enhanced the company’s growth and continued success with one
19 hundred sixty six employees and a fleet of eighty-three customer service vehicles.

20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Hiyoshi’s plans after retirement include starting up his own
21 Wi-Fi router business out of his residence in Tokyo, Japan targeting the international
22 tourism market; now therefore be it

23 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuâttro Na*
24 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
25 people of Guam, recognize, commend, and congratulate Jun Hiyoshi on the occasion
26 of his retirement on March 26, 2018; and to further expressing a most sincere *Un*
27 *Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for his eight (8) years as an outstanding
