




1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Attorney Alicia Anne Garrido Limtiaco is the embodiment of a
4 social worker working in the legal system to protect the rights of the
5 disenfranchised members of our community; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Alicia received her Bachelor of Science degree in Business
7 Administration from the University of Southern California, then her Juris Doctor
8 degree from the University of California at Los Angeles School of Law and is a
9 member of the Guam Bar and California Bar Associations; and

10 **WHEREAS,** Attorney Limtiaco served as the U.S. Attorney for the Districts
11 of Guam and the CNMI from June 2010 until March 2017. She was nominated by
12 President Barack Obama and was confirmed by the United States Senate; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Alicia served as the Attorney General of Guam from January
2 2007 to June 2010. She was the first woman to serve as the United States Attorney
3 for the Districts of Guam and the CNMI and as the elected Attorney General of
4 Guam; and

5 **WHEREAS**, as the United States Attorney, Alicia chaired the Law
6 Enforcement Coordinating Committee, Human Trafficking Task Force and
7 Coalition, Diverse Community Outreach Coalition, Project Safe Childhood and
8 Gang Resistance and Education Training (GREAT) Coalition, Red Ribbon; and

9 **WHEREAS**, as the Attorney General of Guam, Limtiaco led initiatives that
10 addressed public school system health and safety; internet crimes against children
11 including sexual exploitation and child pornography; cybersecurity and cybercrime
12 including identity theft; gambling and gaming; human trafficking; and the
13 implementation and compliance of Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act
14 (SORNA) requirements by the Government of Guam; and

15 **WHEREAS**, she served as the Chair of the Executive Branch of the Family
16 Violence and Sexual Assault Task Force and was an active member of the Sexual
17 Assault Response Team (SART) Steering Committee; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in addition to working at the micro and macro levels to help
19 our island's most vulnerable populations, Alicia also taught at the University of
20 Guam in the Public Administration and Legal Studies Program; and at the Guam
21 Community College, Criminal Justice Program and Basic Law Enforcement
22 Academy, training Guam's future law enforcement officers; and

23 **WHEREAS**, she is a daughter of Guahan who has served our community
24 tirelessly and is deserving of the NASW Public Citizen Award; now therefore be it

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na*
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the

1 people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Attorney Alicia A.G. Limtiaco on
2 being awarded the 2018 Public Citizen Award of the National Association of
3 Social Workers-Guam Chapter; and be it further

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
