




3 **WHEREAS**, she has been employed at the Guam Behavioral Health and
4 Wellness Center since 2014 and works at the Children and Adolescent Services
5 Division providing counseling services to children, youth and adolescents; and

6 **WHEREAS**, her primary focus and specialty work includes working with
7 youth children under age 10 and working with children and youth that have
8 suffered from various physical, sexual and emotional abuse; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Lynnette worked and completed her license as a Licensed
10 Clinical Social Worker in 2017. She is also a licensed professional counselor with
11 the Guam Allied Health Board; and

1 **WHEREAS**, at GBHWC, she is one of the lead facilitators for group work
2 where she provides group therapy on emotion regulation and other skill building
3 group therapy sessions. She was instrumental in researching and advocating in
4 getting a trainer on Guam to provide training for Trauma Focused Cognitive
5 Behavior Therapy; and

6 **WHEREAS**, through her advocacy, staff from GBHWC and others in the
7 community including the Guam Judiciary and Guam Department of Education are
8 working on getting certification for Train the Trainers on TFCBT. She also is
9 working on getting certified as a Play Therapist and hopes to complete this
10 certification soon; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Lynnette has been involved in various NASW committees in
12 the early years of her career as a Social Worker and continues to stay involved in
13 her professional organization. She is currently NASW Guam Chapter Secretary
14 serving a 2- year term in office and has been a member since 2004; and

15 **WHEREAS**, One of Lynnette's greatest achievements was being involved
16 in the Social Work Reinvestment Initiative, where she was instrumental in
17 advocating for licensure on Guam. In 2012, public law 31-250, Social Work
18 Practice Act was signed into law; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Lynnette, a resident of Nimitz Hill is married to happily
20 married to Mr. Juan Arriola; and

21 **WHEREAS**, it is through her continued passion in working with children,
22 youth and families that she was selected as 2018 Social Worker of the Year
