WHEREAS, the Guam HAWGS Motorcycle Club was established in June 1993 as a non-profit organization, to help support the needs of children within the community by providing financial contributions. The Guam HAWGS officers and members also foster and promote activities for the well-being and morale of its membership, and promote a sense of brotherhood among island residents who own a motorcycle or trike; and

WHEREAS, the Guam HAWGS has been instrumental in increasing public awareness about motorcycle safety, and has participated in numerous events to encourage the community to ride safely. The Guam HAWGS continues to create goodwill and a positive public relationship within our island community because of its devotion to helping others; and friendship, equality, and patriotism are qualities that the group is known for; and

WHEREAS, the Guam HAWGS continues to be successful in holding five (5) annual official club functions:

In May - the "Memorial Day Run" - A tribute to the men and women of all military branches, with the theme, LAID TO REST, FIGHTING FOR OUR FREEDOM;

In July - the "Christmas in July" - A visit to the children in all of Guam's public, private, and military hospitals, where the children receive early Christmas presents, such as books, games, toys, and stuffed animals;

In July - during the annual Liberation Day Parade, the Guam HAWGS pays tribute to the people of Guam and the U.S. soldiers who suffered during the Japanese occupation and liberation, from December 1941 to July 1944, by joining other motorcycle enthusiasts and revving their motorcycle engines to indicate the start of the Parade with the sound of a loud roar along the parade route;

In November - a "Veteran's Day Run" is held to honor the men and women of all military branches who serve our country;

In December - a "Christmas Candy Run" is conducted by the Guam HAWGS and other motorcycle enthusiasts who ride through the various Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) neighborhoods around the island distributing five thousand bags (5,000) of candy to the children; in addition, the Guam HAWGS solicits assistance from local schools' Parent Teacher Organizations to bag candies for the "Christmas Candy Run;" and in exchange, the Guam HAWGS makes a monetary donation for their services and/or gives them Box Tops for Education coupons; and

WHEREAS, the Guam HAWGS has provided monetary contributions to over four hundred (400) families with children in need to help with medical expenses; and the club also donates various school supplies to Sanctuary of Guam, Incorporated, as well as toiletry and baby supplies to Alee Shelter. The Guam HAWGS also supports and participates in the "Toys for Tots" program in conjunction with KUAM CareForce and the U.S. Marine Corps; and

WHEREAS, the Guam HAWGS conducts an annual Golf Tournament and various fundraising activities, such as a Poker Run and the raffling of a motorcycle, to replenish the Children Fund. 
