8 young cadets to be better citizens; and through this program they gain skills such as
9 leadership, loyalty, duty, respect, selfless service, honor, integrity and personal courage;

11 **WHEREAS**, students in the GW JROTC, “Warriors” Battalion continue to carry
12 on core values and traditions that are in line with the United States Armed Forces.

1 The Cadets, Officers, Instructors and their supporters have worked tirelessly to ensure
2 that the GW JROTC represents George Washington High School with great pride the
3 GW-JROTC continues to outshine high schools in the nation because of its recent
4 achievements during the Annual Golden Bear West Coast National Drill Meet held
