WHEREAS, Mr. Lizama was drafted into military service in 1965 when he was nineteen 19 years old He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War, and he earned the Combat Infantry Badge and the Bronze Star for his courageous military service, and WHEREAS, upon his return to Guam after serving honorably in the Vietnam War, Mr Lizama attended the niversity of Guam, where he studied

Mechanical and Architectural Drafting; and, he also took classes in Anthropology after being encouraged by Dr. Ted Burkdahl to do so. While taking these irses, he concentrated on doing pen and ink drawings of Guam, its people, resources, environment, and historical artifacts; and WHEREAS, through his invaluable knowledge of the location of *latte* sites on Guam, Mr Lizama was instrumental in the archaeological inventory

survey of Guam's pre historic sites, which were conducted by Fred M. Reinman, Curator of Oceanic Archaeology and Ethnology of the Natural History Museum in Chicago, Illinois. These historical and archaeological sites were eventually placed on the Guam and National Registers of Historic Places; and WHEREAS, Mr. Lizama served as an Archaeological Technician II in the Territorial Archaeology Laboratory of the Guam Department of Parks and

latte sites on Guam were included in the Guam Historic Properties Inventory, and his design was used for the wedding bell structure at Puntan Des Amantes (Two Lover's Point); and

WHEREAS, in addition to his work as a preservationist, Mr. Lizama is a passionate and outspoken advocate for indigenous self-determination, the decolonization of Guam, and the return of CHamory; and

WHEREAS, although formally reured from the Guam Historic Resources Division, Mr Lizama continues to fight for the protection and preservation of Guam's *CHamory* hereage and culture, and he continues to speak out against the injustices experienced by the *I amory* people throughout history, and **WHEREAS**, it is the sense of *I Labelaturan Guaban* that when individuals of such noble aims and accomplishments, such as Mr. Alejandro Teodoro Blas Lizama, are brought to its attention, they should be celebrated and recognized throughout the island, now therefore, be it


