

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUÁTTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1958, Hawaiian Rock Products (HRP) was formed by their
4 founding parent company, Dillingham Corporation, to perform a contract for asphalt
5 paving on the runways and taxiways at Anderson Air Force Base. In August 1958, their
6 main quarry property at Fadian was leased from the Bamba Family; and

7 **WHEREAS**, today, asphalt paving remains the core part of their business; but
8 has expanded into Aggregate sales, Ready-mix Concrete, Hollow Block, Concrete Pipe,
9 Paver Blocks, Pre-cast Manholes and Retaining Wall System (Keystone) Supplies; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1988, they re-established their operations in Saipan, producing
11 Quarry products, Ready Mix Concrete and performing Asphalt Paving from their Obyan
12 quarry. HRP also has an asphalt plant on Tinian; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in August 1990, HRP was purchased by Mitsubishi Cement
14 Corporation Development (MCCD) and Mitsubishi Corporation (MC). MCCD has

1 provided them with great support to develop and expand HRP to meet the needs of the
2 Construction Industry in Guam and the CNMI; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock Products Safety Department consists of safety
4 professionals specializing in various aspects of manufacturing and construction. They
5 have created a safety culture within the construction business that has become the
6 baseline for their company on Guam – “Safety shall be the first objective”; and

7 **WHEREAS**, another essential goal is providing the best quality products. To
8 guarantee quality production, they operate an in-house Quality Control Laboratory. By
9 controlling the entire production process from start to finish, they ensure the definite
10 quality of every product they sell; and

11 **WHEREAS**, HRP operates three (3) ready mixed concrete plants on Guam
12 located in Agat, Fadian, and Anderson Air Force Base. Their operational plants allows
13 them to produce large quantities of concrete from alternate plants, should the need arise;
14 and

15 **WHEREAS**, their equipment service and repair shop perform “In-House”
16 repairs and service, both on the project site and in their shop to ensure that plants and
17 equipment are available to service their customers’ needs; and

18 **WHEREAS**, their local workforce today includes seventy (70) salaried
19 employees and two hundred seventy (270) hourly workers. Their average employee
20 have been with HRP for 14.6 years, with a few salaried employees having more than
21 forty five (45) years of service under their belt; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock Products takes great pride in having been part of
23 building the Marianas for over sixty (60) years. They look forward to being an essential
24 part in the progress of our island’s future. Their pledge and dedication is best
25 represented by some of the projects they have supplied materials for and completed
26 such as numerous hotels, roads, and highways around the island, various distinguished

1 private companies, housing, runways and taxiways of the Guam International Airport
2 and the Anderson Air Force Base, and roadways in all the Military installations; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock Products in conjunction with the best in the
4 industry to ensure that their projects are met with quality and reliability. It is evident in
5 the numerous awards and recognitions that they have received over the years; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Hawaiian Rock Products lives by a corporate philosophy for the
7 prosperity of Guam and their company. They are committed to providing the safest and
8 healthiest environment for their employees and customers; manufacturing only the
9 highest quality products; providing unsurpassed service to their customers; and
10 respecting our environment by reducing energy consumption and by recycling; now
11 therefore, be it
