

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:***

4 **WHEREAS,** Corrections Officer III Teddy P. Gumabon was born and
5 raised on Guam and together with his wife Rose Gumabon and his two
6 daughters and his son, resides in the village of Barrigada; and

7 **WHEREAS,** Corrections Officer III Teddy P. Gumabon began his
8 government service career with the Department of Corrections June 20, 1983; and

9 **WHEREAS,** in September of 1985, Corrections Officer III Teddy P.
10 Gumabon was promoted to Corrections Officer II and rose to the rank of Corrections
11 Officer III in November of 1985 ; and

12 **WHEREAS,** Corrections Officer III Teddy P. Gumabon served the Department
13 in different capacities including membership in committees within the Department and
14 as a member of the Department softball team; and

16 **WHEREAS**, over the course of his career with the Department of
17 Corrections, Corrections Officer III Teddy P. Gumabon was assigned to various
18 units including the Adult Correctional Facility, Unit Manager for Post 7 which is the
19 Administrative and Segregation Unit for Inmates, and the Hagåtña Detention Facility ;

21 **WHEREAS**, Corrections Officer III Teddy P. Gumabon’s current assignment
22 is at the Vocational Rehabilitation Shop Section, which has inmates working at the
23 Auto Shop, Farm, Carpentry, Plumbing and Electrical shops; and

24 **WHEREAS**, on September 28, 2018, thirty-four years, three months and
25 twenty-three days after first being employed there, Corrections Officer III Teddy P.
26 Gumabon will retire from Government of Guam service with the Department of
27 Corrections; and

28 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* knows well that our Corrections Officers
29 keep us safe from convicted, hardened criminals and that without them our criminal
30 justice system would collapse; and

31 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* also is aware that it takes a special kind of
32 person who can endure the stress and responsibilities required of our Corrections
33 Officers and that it is right and fitting that we all recognize and honor those who make
34 corrections work a career. Now therefore, be it

35 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na*
36 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
37 of Guam, recognizes and commends Corrections Officer III Teddy P. Gumabon for
38 his many years of service to the people of Guam and congratulates him on the
39 occasion of his retirement from the Department of Corrections; and be further

40 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
41 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of

42 the same be thereafter transmitted to Corrections Officer III Teddy P. Gumabon and to
43 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.
