BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

WHEREAS, in 1992, a group of local residents, which included business people, teachers, accountants, engineers, and government and private sector employees, each in different fields of expertise, shared a common goal to give back to the community. This desire led to the formation of the *Guahan* Lions Club, which was formed on March 23, 1992, under the umbrella of the International Association of Lions Clubs. Two (2) months later, on May 24, 1992, the *Guahan* Lions Club held a formal induction ceremony at the former Palace Hotel in *Tamuning*, which is now the Sheraton Laguna Hotel; and

WHEREAS, the *Guahan* Lions Club was sponsored by the Guam Marianas Lions Club under the presidency of Lion Regie Reyes, along with Lion Manny de Guzman as the Guiding Lion, and Past District Governor Leslie Moreno, who served as the Extension Chairman at the time, representing the Lions Clubs International for Guam and Micronesia; and

WHEREAS, the *Guahan* Lions Club celebrates its twenty-sixth (26th) year anniversary with its charter members, which include: Evelyn Angeles, Cely Aquino, Thelma Barroso, Fely Co, Monito Co, Bella Duplito, Fernando Duplito, Aida Fernandez, Fred Flores, Mirasol Flores, Rose Hidalgo, Nydia Llatenas, Cely Nisperos, Romy Nisperos, Lulu Ollamor, Rolly Ricabar, Yully Ricabar, Nora Sica, Bernie Tiong, Lani Tiong, Emelio Uy, and Gloria Villanueva. Lion Rolly Ricabar is the current Charter President; Lion Emelio Uy is the Charter 1st Vice President; Lion Fred Flores is the Charter 2nd Vice President; Lion Aida Fernandez is the Charter 3rd Vice President; Lion Nydia Llatenas is the Charter Secretary; and Lion Mirasol Flores is the Charter Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, throughout its twenty-six (26) years of service to the community, the members and officers of the *Guahan* Lions Club have held several fundraising activities that has helped to sustain their community services and projects that will benefit the people of Guam. In March 2016, the *Guahan* Lions Club recruited twenty-seven (27) new members who were inducted in April 2016; and, as of September 2018, the *Guahan* Lions Club has a total of fifty-two (52) members that are active in helping our community through their services and donations; and

WHEREAS, the *Guahan* Lions Club has undertaken several community projects island-wide, such as the "Operation Graffiti Wipe-out Campaign," which was held on May 20, 1995, during which hundreds of volunteers from all walks of life, including students, government officials, company executives, and employees — young and old, gathered together at the various Mayors' Offices throughout the island with paint, brushes, and rollers on hand, and painted over graffiti at various locations. After the initial campaign, members of the Club went out every weekend to different villages to paint over graffiti-damaged walls, bus stops, and other structures; and

WHEREAS, in 1995, the *Guahan* Lions Club supported and campaigned for the passage of Bill No. 98, which was introduced by Senator Tony Lamorena and became Public Law 23-27 on June 27, 1995, relative to graffiti-related crimes and regulating the sale of permanent ink markers and spray paint to minors; and

WHEREAS, the *Guahan* Lions Club remains actively involved in our community with various projects, such as: the installation of a *Tamuning-Deledo* village boundary sign on Marine Corps Drive; decorating *Guma Trankilidat* during the Christmas season; cleaning up and co-adopting the *Liguan Terrace* neighborhood park; donating wheelchairs to the Guam Memorial Hospital, St. Dominic's Senior Care Home, and the Skilled Nursing Unit; the donation of canes and walkers to clients at *Guma Trankilidat* and serving dinner to the elderly; adopting two (2) bus stops that are cleaned and maintained on a regular basis; feeding the hungry and homeless; supporting diabetes and cancer organizations by making monetary donations; participating and helping in the District 204's Health Fair project, which promotes health care and awareness of cancer and diabetes; supporting the youth by sponsoring various schools in the Peace Poster Contest — building and exposing our youth by showing their talent in the arts; participating at various International Conventions and Orient Southeast Asia Lions Forums (OSEAL) in various parts of the world; and participating and supporting various activities of the District, and other fellow Lions Clubs on Guam and other regions; and
