4 Carbullido in 1982 and was the Association's first President which began with only 7
5 members; and

7 second President with members raising to what is more than 80 members to date; and

8 **WHEREAS,** as a committee support group, the Guam Diabetes Association
9 has members and families that struggle with diabetes and reaches out by having
10 monthly diabetes sessions, membership and board meetings; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the mission of the Guam Diabetes Association is fulfilled in the
12 active participation of each member, reaching out with educational awareness and
13 insight to all the people on Guam who, in one way or another, is affected by diabetes;

1 **WHEREAS**, the 19th Annual Guam Diabetes Conference is spearheaded by the
