BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

WHEREAS, Dr. Robert L. Haddock, D.V.M., M.P.H. was born on April 7, 1938, in Detroit, Michigan; and, is the son of Lyton Albert Haddock and Ruth Lillian Haddock; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haddock is married to Dr. Olivia Leola Torres Cruz, MD; and they have two (2) children — a daughter, Michele Renate Cruz Haddock, and a son, Ray Lynton Cruz Haddock, Esq. and Carla Torres Haddock. They are also blessed with six (6) grandchildren, Robert Lynton Torres Haddock, Olivia Lourdes Torres Haddock, Francisco Ray Haddock, Carlos James Torres Haddock, Gregorio Lucas Torres Haddock, and Stephen Thomas Haddock; and

WHEREAS, in 1962, Dr. Haddock attained his Bachelor of Science Degree from Michigan State University; and, then earned a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine Degree (D.V.M.) from the University of Hawaii in 1964, where he specialized in communicable disease epidemiology with special interest in the enteric diseases and zoonoses. He continued his education and attained his Master of Public Health Degree (M.P.H.) from the University of Hawaii in 1968, followed by his Post-Doctoral Certification in Epidemiology and Control of Communicable Diseases at the Central Institute for Advanced Medical Training in Moscow, USSR, and the High Institute of Public Health at the University of Alexandria in Egypt in 1974; and

WHEREAS, having lobbied for the establishment of a population-based cancer registry for Guam, Dr. Haddock became the first Director of the Guam Cancer Registry as a collateral duty to his position as Territorial Epidemiologist. The Guam Cancer Registry remained an unfunded mandate of the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) until funding was provided under the US6 grant; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haddock's untiring efforts resulted in the following achievements for the people of Guam: recognizing cancer as the second (2nd) leading cause of death in Guam, which resulted in the passage of Public Law 24-198 in 1998, making cancer a legally reportable disease and reestablishing the Guam Cancer Registry (GCR) under the purview and regulation of DPHSS; and, establishing the prospective collection of reports of new cases of cancer on Guam in which, previously, additional data on earlier cancer cases were gathered by reviewing death certificate records in the Office of Vital Statistics dating back to 1970, the year that the standardized national death certificate was adopted for use on Guam. Data on cancer cases diagnosed before 1998 was also collected by reviewing files of the American Cancer Society, Guam Chapter. Furthermore, in 2004, the Cancer Research Center of Guam (CRCG) was established as a joint venture of the University of Guam, DPHSS, the University of Hawaii, and the National Institutes of Health to address Health Disparities in Minority Populations. The GCR was able to hire a full-time data collection specialist, which greatly improved its ability to collect more accurate and complete information regarding Guam cancer cases; and

WHEREAS, in 2006, under Dr. Haddock's directorship and in recognition of its progress, the GCR was awarded full-member status in the North American Association of Central Cancer Registries (NAACCR), which it maintains to the present day; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haddock assisted with plans developed by the University of Hawaii to establish a Pacific Central Cancer Registry at the CRCG serving all the U.S. affiliated Pacific island countries and territories, with funding from the National Center for Disease Control (NCDC). In February 2007, a second (2nd) data collection specialist was hired and the Pacific Regional Central Cancer Registry (PRCCR) became operational, and is located at the CRCG; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haddock, as a member of the Internal Advisory Committee of the Guam Comprehensive Cancer Control Program (GCCCP), helped with the passage of Public Law 30-89 in October 2010, which expanded mandatory cancer reporting to include non-medical providers, such as insurance companies; and, he established a dedicated source of funding for GCR via one percent (1%) of tobacco taxes collected annually; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haddock self-published a book, *A History of Health on Guam*, in 2010, the only one of its kind; and, he has generously donated many of these books to the Cancer Center of Guam; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haddock has eleven (11) published manuscripts and four (4) abstracts dating from 2009 to 2016, in addition to eighty-one (81) publications dating from 1969 to 2013, and has presented at fifteen (15) diverse conferences; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'trentai Kuattro Na Liheslaturan Guahan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guahan and the people of Guam, recognize, commend, and congratulate Dr. Robert L. 


