1 WHEREAS, physical fitness is paramount to the nature of core activities associated with Guam's peace officers, our local law enforcement entities, and the 2 3 ability to keep our island safe and protect our people; and WHEREAS, in 1998, Public Law 24-145 established the Peace Officer 4 Standards and Training (POST) Commission, which was initially created with the 5 intention of developing regulations and minimum professional standards to serve as the 6 basis for the uniform recruitment operation of government of Guam law enforcement 7 8 entities; and later extended to include Guam's Category 1 and 2 peace officers; and WHEREAS, since 1998, several pieces of legislation, including Public Law 29-9 012, Public Law 31-099, Public Law 32-232, and Public Law 34-49, have been passed 10 which were all aimed at improving and updating Guam law, as well as the rules and 11 12 regulations, regarding the POST Commission; and WHEREAS, the POST Commission's current Category 1 and 2 peace officer 13 member entities are Guam Police Department (GPD); Guam Department of Education 14 (GDOE); Customs and Quarantine Agency (CQA); Port Authority of Guam (PAG); 15 A.B.
