WHEREAS, on October 22, 2018, Senator Telena Cruz Nelson introduced Bill No. 365-34 (COR), which reflected the recommendations of the POST Commission on the Physical Fitness Qualifications Test standards; and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan's* Committee on Housing, Utilities, Public Safety, and Homeland Security convened a public hearing on the bill on November 1, 2018, where a majority of the POST Commission's member entities were present to provide testimony and explain the PFQT standards recommendations specific to their respective entities; and

WHEREAS, Bill No. 365-34 (COR) was discussed on the session floor by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on November 28, 2018, and passed unanimously on November 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2018, Substitute Bill No. 365-34 (COR), "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 3116 TO CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 27, GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS, RELATIVE TO THE ADOPTION OF THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING (POST) COMMISSION'S PHYSICAL FITNESS QUALIFICATIONS TEST (PFQT) STANDARDS," was signed into law by *I Maga'åhån Guåhan*, and designated as Public Law 34-136; and

WHEREAS, through the implementation of a physical fitness program, a health and nutrition program, and a physical fitness qualifications test which are entity-specific, the provisions of Public Law 34-136 will help to ensure that government of Guam law enforcement entities can properly prepare and support our island's more than one thousand one hundred (1,100) Category 1 and 2 peace officers to perform their jobs of protecting the people of Guam; now therefore, be it

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, a peace officer is a sworn officer who acts in the capacity to uphold**
4 **the law which, at times, may be dynamic and requires certain physical capabilities; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, physical fitness is paramount to the nature of core activities
2 associated with Guam's peace officers, our local law enforcement entities, and the
3 ability to keep our island safe and protect our people; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in 1998, Public Law 24-145 established the Peace Officer
5 Standards and Training (POST) Commission, which was initially created with the
6 intention of developing regulations and minimum professional standards to serve as the
7 basis for the uniform recruitment operation of government of Guam law enforcement
8 entities; and later extended to include Guam's Category 1 and 2 peace officers; and

9 **WHEREAS**, since 1998, several pieces of legislation, including Public Law 29-
10 012, Public Law 31-099, Public Law 32-232, and Public Law 34-49, have been passed
11 which were all aimed at improving and updating Guam law, as well as the rules and
12 regulations, regarding the POST Commission; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the POST Commission's current Category 1 and 2 peace officer
14 member entities are Guam Police Department (GPD); Guam Department of Education
15 (GDOE); Customs and Quarantine Agency (CQA); Port Authority of Guam (PAG);
16 A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam (GIAA); Guam Fire Department
17 (GFD); Department of Agriculture (DOAg); Department of Corrections (DOC);
18 Judiciary of Guam (JOG); Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR); Office of the
19 Attorney General (OAG); and Department of Youth Affairs (DYA); and

20 **WHEREAS**, Public Law 34-49, which was signed into law by *I Maga'låhen*
21 *Guåhan* on October 13, 2017, sought to amend the rules and regulations of the POST
22 Commission, and mandated that the Commission submit modified or new Physical
23 Fitness Qualifications Test (PFQT) standards recommendations for adoption by *I*
24 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* which included (1) a physical fitness program; (2) a health and
25 nutrition program; and (3) a physical fitness qualifications test; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in response to the provisions contained in Public Law 34-49, the
2 Commission established a Research and Development (R&D) Subcommittee to
3 determine suitable physical fitness programs for the Commission's member entities;
4 and

5 of the R&D Subcommittee were subsequently approved by the POST Commission and


