WHEREAS, Lieutenant Jennifer Zeigler served in the Ambulatory Procedure 3 Unit and Post Anesthesia Care Unit at the U.S. Naval Hospital (USNH) Guam from 4 January 2014 to April 2017. During her service on Guam, her noteworthy 5 accomplishments were many and her efforts fostered unity within the community; and 6 WHEREAS, the Command End of Life Program Director, she coordinated, 7 Eganized, and instructed three (3) End of Life courses to fifty-two (52) military 8 healthcare professionals and civilian nurses at the Veteran's Administration Clinic and 9 other local medical treatment facilities. It enabled all participants to be better equipped 10 to care for, provide education to, have crucial conversations with, and advocate for 11 patients and their family members in a holistic, multi-disciplinary, and culturally 12 sensitive approach. Additionally, she streamlined the Essentris Electronic Health 13 Record (EHR) End of Life Set that ensured standardized comfort care measures to all 14 15 dying patients; and

WHEREAS, as a strong patient advocate, she initiated and authored the USNH Guam End of Life Care Brochure as a resource to educate patients and family members. As a subject matter expert, Lt. Zeigler was sought out by Guam Comprehensive Cancer Control Coalition as a panelist for the 2015 Palliative Care Conference attended by two hundred (200) medical care providers on Guam; and WHEREAS, a seasoned and certified Wound Care nurse, she taught pressure

WHEREAS, a seasoned and certified Wound Care nurse, she taught pressure and ulcer prevention and wound care principles to three hundred seventy-one (371) nurses and Corpsmen during the annual Nursing Skills Fair and during the monthly Command Orientation to all incoming healthcare personnel. A knowledgeable clinician, she independently managed patients in the ambulatory care settings and inpatient units who are at risk or have developed early signs of skin breakdown by utilizing evidence-based wound care principles that either prevented or promoted wound care healing; and

WHEREAS, Lt. Zeigler was well known amongst members of the Guam Nurses Association, she was asked to be a guest speaker at the 2016 Guam Nurses Association Annual Nursing Convention. She presented "Opioid Abuse Among Health Care Workers" to ninety-eight (98) military nurses and local civilian health care providers and nurses. The presentation increased awareness and generated robust discussion amongst those in attendance as it is a relevant issue facing all healthcare professionals during the present time; and

WHEREAS, she is a distinguished ambassador and civic minded individual, she has volunteered numerous hours towards the Islandwide Beautification Task Force, the 2016 Annual Guam Coastal Clean-up, and the International Lion's Club, District 204 Adopt-a-Road efforts (2016-2017). She organized and recruited other hospital staff during the *Guahan Ayudante's* Adopt-a-Road clean-up activities and

dedicated many off-duty hours painting and maintaining a bus stop that was adopted by the *Guahan Ayudante* Lions Club; and

WHEREAS, she eagerly volunteered her expertise during the Lion's Club International's (LCI) Annual Medical Health Fair 2016 where she provided blood pressure screening and health counseling to over five hundred underprivileged people on Guam. She was sought out by members of the LCI's Board of Directors to spearhead and organize the recruitment and oversight of the screening tables for the Annual LCI Medical Health Fair 2017. She also provided nursing coverage during the International Lions Club, District 204, first Annual 5K Run/Walk event and helped raise over \$5,000 towards the beautification of the children's playground in *Hagatna*; and

WHEREAS, she is a strong supporter of the United Service Organization (USO) Guam and has volunteered her time during several of their activities, such as the coastal clean-up and the 2016 Guam International Marathon manning the Sasa Bay tent; and

WHEREAS, having recently joined the *Guahan Ayudante* Lions Club in April 2016, she has performed in an exemplary manner that is worthy of recognition. She ardently stepped up to the plate when the club's secretary resigned unexpectedly and has been very active and supportive of all planned meetings, events and activities that has inspired club members; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Jennifer Zeigler's admirable performance, leadership, and invaluable community service with numerous organizations on Guam will be remembered and appreciated; now therefore, be it
