



1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Alicia Anne Garrido Limtiaco was born on August 7, 1963 and is
4 the proud daughter of Francisco and Julia Limtiaco; and

5 **WHEREAS,** Alicia Limtiaco received her Bachelor of Science Degree in
6 Business Administraton from the University of Southern California (USC) in 1985;
7 and her Juris Doctorate from the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA)
8 School of Law in 1990; and

9 **WHEREAS,** Alicia Limtiaco worked as Adjunct Faculty and Assistant
10 Professor with the University of Guam, College of Professional Studies, School of

1 Business and Public Administration for almost eight years; and served with the Guam
2 Community College, Criminal Justice Program and Basic Law Enforcement Academy
3 for over six years, training potential individuals in Guam’s future law enforcement
4 industry; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco served as Attorney General for Guam from
6 January 1, 2007 to June 21, 2010; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in February 2010, Alicia Limtiaco was nominated by President
8 Barack Obama to serve as the United States Attorney for the Districts of Guam and
9 the Northern Mariana Islands. She was confirmed by the United States Senate in April
10 2010; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco became the first Chamorro female United States
12 Attorney, serving Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands until March 13, 2017; and

13 **WHEREAS**, throughout her successful career, Alicia has received numerous
14 commendations from various organizations, such as the 1999 “Outstanding Woman of
15 the Year” award. In May 2012, Alicia Limtiaco was honored as the “Sorooptimist
16 Founder Region Ruby Award” recipient in California for her role in empowering
17 women in their personal and professional activities; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco was the recipient of the “Visionary Voice
19 Award,” in March 2014 presented by the National Sexual Violence Resource Center,
20 honoring individuals throughout the country for their outstanding work in the field of
21 anti-sexual violence within their communities; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Office of the Secretary of Defense Employee Support of the
23 Guard and Support (ESGR) commended Alicia Limtiaco with the “Patriotic Employer
24 Award”; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco was honored as the recipient of the “2015
26 Alumnus of the Year Award” by the UCLA Asian Pacific Islander Law Students

1 Association. She was recognized for her contributions to the Asian and Pacific
2 Islander communities, and is the first Pacific Islander to receive the award; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco has been a huge advocate for upholding the
4 dignity of human life through her tireless efforts in combating human sex trafficking,
5 such as the formation of task forces and the implementation of the Sex Offender
6 Registration and Notification Act (SORNA) requirements by the Government of
7 Guam; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco has served as the Ninth Circuit Lawyer
9 Representative for the District of Guam, as a Judicial Extern with the United States
10 Court for the District of California, and as a Law Clerk for the Superior Court of
11 Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Alicia Limtiaco celebrates her service to the island of Guam with
13 her husband, Vince Munoz and their daughter, Julia Faye Munoz; now, therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuattro Na*
15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and
16 commending Alicia Anne Garrido Limtiaco for her outstanding accomplishments as
17 the United States Attorney General for the districts of Guam and the Northern
18 Mariana Islands and further extends *Un Dangkolo na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to her for her
19 commitment and exemplary service to the people of Guam and to Guam's Justice
20 System; and be it further

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
22 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
23 the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Alicia Anne Garrido Limtiaco;
