1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2           ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** A group of business people, teachers, accountants, engineers,  
4 government and private employees, each in different fields of expertise shared a  
5 common goal, which is to give back to the community. It was later that the Guahan  
6 Lions Club formed the charter and was approved by the International Association of  
7 Lions Clubs in March 23, 1992. Two (2) months later, the Guahan Lions Club held a  
8 formal induction ceremony on Guam on May 24, 1992 at the then Palace Hotel  
9 ballroom in Tumon, Guam; and

10           **WHEREAS,** the Guahan Lions Club was sponsored by the Guam Marianas  
11 Lions Club under the presidency of Lion Regie Reyes along with Lion Manny de  
12 Guzman as the Guiding Lion and the Past District Governor Leslie Moreno who  
13 served as the extension chairman at the time representing the Lions Clubs

1 International for Guam and Micronesia; and

2       **WHEREAS**, the Guahan Lions Club celebrates this anniversary with its charter  
3 members, namely Evelyn Angeles; Cely Aquino; Thelma Barrozo; Fely Co; Monito  
4 Co; Bella Duplito; Fernando Duplito; Aida Fernandez; Fred Flores; Mirasol Flores;  
5 Rose Hidalgo; Nydia Llarenas; Cely Nisperos; Romy Nisperos; Lulu Oliamot; Rolly  
6 Ricabar; Yolly Ricabar; Nora Sicad; Bernie Tiong; Lani Tiong; Emelio Uy and Gloria  
7 Villanueva. Lion Rolly Ricabar is the current charter president; Lion Emelio Uy as the  
8 charter 1<sup>st</sup> vice president; Lion Fred Flores as the charter 2<sup>nd</sup> vice president; Lion Aida  
9 Fernandez as the charter 3<sup>rd</sup> vice president; Lion Nydia Llarenas as the charter  
10 secretary and Lion Mirasol Flores as the charter treasurer; and

11       **WHEREAS**, the Guahan Lions Club throughout its twenty-five (25) years of  
12 service to the community, members and officers of Guahan Lions Club has held  
13 several fund raising activities and foremost among these activities are two (2) very  
14 successful concerts of famous Philippines singer – Mr. Gary Valenciano and his group  
15 in 1994 and 1996 to a full-house audience at the UOG Fieldhouse. The Guahan Lions  
16 Club has also provided many levels of service over its Twenty Five (25) year history  
17 which help to improve the environment, healthcare, elderly and youth care and  
18 disaster relief; and

19       **WHEREAS**, Guahan Lions Club have undertaken some community projects  
20 Island wide such has, “Operation Graffiti Wipe-out Campaign” which started in May  
21 20, 1995 wherein hundreds of volunteers from all-walks of life – students,  
22 government officials, company executives, employees, young and old simultaneously

1 gathered at the different mayor's office throughout the island and spread out to the  
2 community with paints and rollers on hand and painted over graffiti at various  
3 locations. After the initial campaign, members of the club went out every weekend to  
4 different villages to paint over graffiti-damaged walls, bus stops and other structures;  
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 2016 the Guahan Lions Club had various activities such as  
7 fundraise and donate wheel chairs to St. Dominic Home Care and the Guam Memorial  
8 Hospital (GMH); cleaned and co-adopted the Ligan Terrace neighborhood park  
9 which includes the bus stop in Ligan, Dededo; the charters annual contribution to the  
10 decorating of the Guma Trankilidat during the Christmas season; and participated in  
11 the various international conventions and Orient Southeast Asia Lions Forums  
12 (OSEAL) in various parts of the world; and

13 **WHEREAS**, this year 2017, the Guahan Lions club has participated in the  
14 Diabetes Health fair held at the Micronesian Mall; the Guam International Airport  
15 Authority Highway cleanup; and is looking forward to assisting in more projects to  
16 come for our island community; now therefore, be it
