Relative to recognizing and commemorating June as LGBTQ Pride Month and expressing gratitude to Guam Pride, Inc., Guam Visitors Bureau, ISA LGBT Guam, Guam's Alternative Lifestyle Association (GALA), and House of Diosa for the celebrations during LGBTQ Pride Month in the month of June 2017; and commending them for their work in promoting the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ) community of Guam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAL KUÅTTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, although the Stonewall Riots of New York City in June of 1969, where patrons of the Stonewall Inn resisted and fought back against police abuse and harassment, is widely considered the start of the modern civil rights movement for lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender (LGBT) equality in the United States and is commemorated each year since in June as LGBT Pride Month; and

WHEREAS, Guam has long been a place where family, friends, and community members who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender (LGBT) feel welcomed and appreciated and where efforts to strengthen our families by

1 recognizing and affirming our LGBT community members in our families, villages,

2 schools, churches, workplaces and under the law continue to progress; and

WHEREAS, in April 2015, Loretta M. Pangelinan and Kathleen M. Aguero and their legal team filed a legal challenge on Guam in Aguero v. Calvo which eventually brought marriage equality for the first time to a U.S. territory; and

WHEREAS, in the Spring of 2015, Jim Obergefell, the named plaintiff in the marriage equality case before the U.S. Supreme Court, travelled to Guam where his father served in WWII and was featured as the University of Guam Commencement Speaker and in the President's Speaker Series, just weeks before his landmark case brought marriage equality nationwide in a 5-4 decision at the U.S. Supreme Court case in Obergefell v. Hodges; and

WHEREAS, the Summer of 2015 brought more progress for LGBT equality on Guam with the passage of P.L. 33-64 the Guam Employment Non-Discrimination Act, introduced by Senator B.J. Cruz, and P.L. 33-64 the Guam Marriage Equality Act of 2015, introduced by Senator Nerissa Bretania Underwood; and

WHEREAS, Guam held its first major Pride LGBT March on June 10, 2017; and it was led by grand marshal Speaker Benjamin J.F. Cruz, who decades earlier had led an impromptu LGBT Pride march with his partner Johnny and friends and continues to make history as one of the only openly-LGBT speakers of a legislature in the country; and

WHEREAS, Guam has begun to invest in cultivating LGBT tourism and has also become a regional destination for same-sex weddings, and with the Guam Visitor's Bureau (GVB) joining the International Gay and Lesbian Travel Association to partner in accessing the LGBT tourism market and promoting Guam during the "Year of Love"; and

WHEREAS, everyday LGBT community members and their supporters 1 continue to make history everyday in their social, familial, political, athletic, business 2 and religious affiliations in our community, including through LGBT organizations 3 like Guam Pride, Inc., ISA LGBT Guam, Guam's Alternative Lifestyle Association 4 (GALA), and the House of Diosa that support and advocate for inclusion of the the 5 6 LGBTQ community year-round; and WHEREAS, the people of Guam are known for their kindness and compassion, 7 and recognize and support the fight for equality and the progress made in creating an 8 island society and world that is more inclusive and accepting; now therefore, be it 9 RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na 10 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 11 of Guam, congratulate Guam Pride, Inc., Guam Visitors Bureau, ISA LGBT Guam, 12 Guam's Alternative Lifestyle Association (GALA), and the House of Diosa on the 13 celebration of LGBTQ Pride Month during the month of June 2017; and does further 14 thank them for their ongoing work in making Guam a better place to live, work and 15 visit for everyone and for promoting the social, economic, cultural and political 16 achievements of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBT) 17 community of Guam and our visitors; and be it further 18 RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 19 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of 20 the same be thereafter transmitted to Guam Pride, Inc.; to ISA LGBT Guam; to 21 Guam's Alternative Lifestyle Association (GALA); to Guam Visitors Bureau; to the 22
