3        **WHEREAS**, hailing from the beautiful village of Malojloj, Inarajan, Mrs.  
4        Lorraine C. Chargualaf is the wife of Anthony V. Chargualaf and the mother of  
5        Kristen L. Cruz, Alyssa R. Cruz, & Anthony J. Cruz; and

6        **WHEREAS**, it was in January of 1981 that Lorraine's service to the Guam  
7        Department of Education began. It was a beginning that would later amount to more  
8        than thirty-six (36) years of dedicated service with one of Guam's most principal  
9        agencies; and

10       **WHEREAS**, Lorraine's career with the Department of Education was one  
11       rooted in the Special Education Program. In her first position with the department, she  
12       served as an on-call substitute teacher under the Special Education Division, providing  
13       assistance to the various public schools on island. For three years, she worked with

1 students with special needs, helping them fully realize their learning abilities. By  
2 accommodating and modifying lessons to suit their needs, she empowered her  
3 students; and

4       **WHEREAS**, when the need for a Data Control Clerk in the division arose in  
5 1983, Lorraine answered the call. For five (5) years, Lorraine contributed greatly to  
6 the inputting and compiling of student data for the division. In 1992, she was  
7 promoted to Secretary II Typist, where she provided typing and word processing work  
8 for her division. As a testament to her hard work, Lorraine was soon again promoted,  
9 this time to the position of Administrative Assistant. Lorraine efficiently performed a  
10 wide variety of difficult and responsible secretarial, administrative and general office  
11 duties. A natural leader, a great team player, and an initiative-taker, she ensured the  
12 smooth success of the division; and

13       **WHEREAS**, in 2009, with the desire to expand her field of service within the  
14 Department of Education, Lorraine became the Administrative Officer for the Gifted  
15 and Talented Education Program, also known as GATE. It is here today, where we  
16 honor her public service career, still so giving and still so passionate of her work in  
17 contributing to the furthering of Guam's education system. Under the Curriculum and  
18 Instruction Division, Lorraine advanced the division's mission of cultivating an
