



3 **WHEREAS**, Ethel S.M. Conlu was born on February 28, 1936 in Malay Aklan,
4 Philippines. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel and Socorro Santa Maria and
5 is the eldest of seven (7) children; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 1957, Ethel married +Dubidato Ureta Conlu and together they
7 had four (4) children, her son Alfred S.M. Conlu and his wife Tessa A. Conlu, her son
8 Dubidato “Dubel” S.M. Conlu, Jr. and Gemma F. Conlu, her daughter +Evelyn C.
9 Tinajero and her husband T.J., Tinajero, and her daughter Elizabeth C. Lopez and her
10 husband Ferdinand L. Lopez; and her seven (7) grandchildren, Jennifer, Kevin John,
11 Kristopher, Ryan, Eryne, Victoria and Vanessa; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Ethel was raised in Malay, Aklan, and as the eldest child, a lot of
13 responsibilities were placed on her to look after her siblings and the upkeep of the
14 family home, doing laundry and preparing family meals. In Ethel’s younger years, she
15 attended Ibajay Academy in Aklan, Philippines where she received her elementary

1 and junior high school education. She also attended Far Eastern University (FEU)
2 before marrying her husband of fifty (50) years; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Ethel was employed and served on the Board of Investment,
4 Manila Commission (under Teofilo Sison) and Manila Budget Commission,
5 Malacanag (under Amable Aguilas). In 1969, Ethel and her family moved to Guam
6 and made it their home. She then landed her job at the Guam Hilton Hotel & Spa
7 where she worked for over thirty-five (35) years; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Ethel had a great vision and passion for business, it was then she
9 opened her own small business named “Dubel Janitorial & Hauling Corporation”
10 which speacializes on Janitorial, Landscaping Services and Carpet and Upholstery
11 Cleaning Services which she owned for twenty-five (25) years and maintained a great
12 working relationship with her clients. As she began thinking about retiring, it is then
13 her Son “Dubel” took over the business and renamed the company to “K Cleaning
14 Services” which handles services of the same; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Ethel is involved in many community groups, namely, an active
16 member with the Agat Guamerica Lions Club which participates in various activies
17 such coastal clean ups, assisting with medical outreaches and other community
18 projects and workshops. She is also involved with the Aklan Association of Guam
19 which made various contributions to the Guam Memorial Hospital, Kalibo Hospital in
20 Aklan, University of Guam, Guam Community College and American Cancer
21 Society. Ethel is also very involved with the Dededo Senior Citizens Center where she
22 loves to assist and participate with the staff and friends. Ethel actively participates in
23 functions of the Filipino community of Guam (FCG) for over thirty (30) years; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Ethel is also a cancer survivor of twenty-five (25) years and has
25 been participating at the American Cancer Society “Relay for Life” at the George
26 Washington High School Track since then; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ethel is described as being a devoted mother and grandmother,
2 exceptionally generous with her time and always putting family first. She is a person
3 of determination and vision which she helped to build the foundation of her children’s
4 success, nurturing them as they grow and explored the great promise of our island, her
5 love inspires her children and grandchildren to achieve their full potential by making
6 the right choices and setting their goals high to become a good citizens; now therefore,
7 be it
