3        **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo continues to be an active member in  
4        good standing since October of 2000, giving sixteen (16) years of service and  
5        contributing over 5,000 volunteer hours as a member of GMHVA; and

6        **WHEREAS**, upon joining GMHVA in 2000, First Lady Christine Calvo took  
7        charge of handling the gift cart sales throughout the hospital, bringing joy to friends,  
8        loved ones and family members while they were at our island's public hospital; and

9        **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo served as a member-at-large on the  
10       GMHVA Executive Board in 2001; and

11       **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo was the overall chairperson for the  
12       33<sup>rd</sup> Annual Charity Ball and Fund Drive in 2001, overseeing all the committees while  
13       also serving as the chairperson of the accommodations committee; and

1           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo co-chaired the 34<sup>th</sup> Annual Charity  
2 Ball and Fund Drive in 2002, serving as part of the entertainment/program and  
3 publicity committee and the tickets committee; and

4           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo served as the membership steering  
5 committee chairperson in 2003; and

6           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo has served as the Honorary President  
7 of the GMH Volunteers Association since January 2010; and

8           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo chaired the 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual Charity Ball  
9 and Fund Drive in 2010 and introduced the corporate sponsorship concept to the  
10 fundraising efforts resulting over \$100,000 net proceeds that year; and now therefore  
11 it be:

12           **WHEREAS**, as a “Pink Lady,” First Lady Christine Calvo has been involved in  
13 many different volunteer roles in the capacity as chair, co-chair, subcommittee  
14 member and/or donor in various programs and fundraising projects of GMHVA

16 SNU Three Kings visits; and

17           **WHEREAS**, as the honorary president of the Guam Council of Women’s  
18 Clubs, First Lady Christine Calvo has made numerous contributions to our island; and

19           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo established a new movement to  
20 strengthen the community through service, the Rigãlu Foundation, which supports a  
21 wide range of community initiatives including foster care, early childhood education,  
22 sports tourism, the arts and humanities, and literacy; and

23           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo is an advocate of our island’s children  
24 and supports children with special needs and their families, co-chairing the Guam  
25 Early Learning Council; and

1           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo promotes sports tourism and our local  
2 athletes, previously serving as the manager of the Guam Rugby Football Union and  
3 Women’s Team, head coach of the Academy of Our Lady of Guam and St. Francis  
4 Catholic School girls’ rugby teams, leading athletes to regional and international  
5 competitions and victories; and

6           **WHEREAS**, First Lady Christine Calvo is married to Governor Eddie Baza  
7 Calvo and has six children – Eddie, Vinson, Rosae, Paul Jerome, Melva and Celine.  
8 When she isn’t working on a passionate project or volunteering, you can find her  
9 spending time with her grandchildren, Eden, Sabian, and Isaac; now therefore be it
