**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:***

**WHEREAS,** Dr. Michael J. Stoil has served in many capacities in the United States and Guam for over 40 years; and

**WHEREAS,** Dr. Stoil has an abundance of accomplishments where he excelled in utilizing his life experience and knowledge to educate many of our island's students; and

**WHEREAS,** Dr. Stoil joined the University of Guam as a member of the faculty in 2007 and was Coordinator of the Political Science Program from 2008 to 2012. As Associate Professor of Political Science, Dr. Stoil's contributions to the University of Guam included: revision of the Political Science Program by replacing outdated course offerings with new courses; rewriting course outlines to incorporate Student Learning Objectives for all political science courses in preparation for the university's reaccreditation process in 2008; served as Chairman for the search committee for two additional full-time, tenure-track faculty positions; directed a five-year program self-review; served as Faculty Advisor of Pi Sigma Alpha Chapter of the

1 University of Guam, the Political Science Honor Society; converted the first political  
2 science courses at UOG to hybrid live/on-line format; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil's contributions to the University of Guam has led to a  
4 12-year high of Political Science Majors, assisting fellow Professors in teaching an  
5 array of courses to help mold and form the minds of their students' intellect, leading  
6 them to reach the top of their class teaching an array of courses; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil also served as an Adjunct Professorial Instructor in  
8 International Relations Program at Troy University in Troy, Alabama teaching  
9 graduate students on-line or on U.S. Military Bases on Intercultural Relations, U.S.  
10 National Security Policy, Survey of International Relations, U.S. Foreign Policy,  
11 Comparative Government and Theory in International Relations; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil served congressional staff members leading to  
13 undergraduate degree in Political Science as an Adjunct Professorial Lecturer in  
14 Political Science in the Capitol Hill Program of George Washington University in  
15 Washington, D.C.; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil was responsible for teaching sections counting for one-  
17 third of course credit in Introduction to Political Science and U.S. Government and  
18 Politics as a Graduate Teaching Fellow in Political Science at the George Washington  
19 University in Washington, D.C.; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil held non-academic positions as a Senior Analyst (Chief  
21 Research Methodologist) for Conwal, Incorporated in McLean, Virginia from 1993 to  
22 2007. He was responsible for the evaluation of the effects of International Law  
23 Enforcement Academy training by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the U.S.  
24 State Department in police forces of the countries of the former U.S.S.R. and Central  
25 Europe; and other research conducted on health promotion, health care financing,  
26 mental health and federally funded substance abuse prevention efforts for various

1 government entities such as the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, the U.S.  
2 Department of Health and Human Services and for the Robert Wood Johnson  
3 Foundation; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil served as the Washington Editor for Medquest  
5 Publications in Cleveland, Ohio from 1989 to 2007. Based in Washington, Dr. Stoil  
6 researched and wrote monthly columns on impacts of national and state politics and  
7 government on health care for *Behavioral Health Management* and *Nursing Homes*  
8 *and Long-term Care*; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil was an Analyst of Kappa Systems for Koba Associates,  
10 and Inter-America Research in Washington, D.C., compiling a Foreign Affairs  
11 Manual under contract to the U.S. State Department. He engaged in research on the  
12 response to terrorist incidents and on command, control and intelligence decision-  
13 making for agencies in the nations' security community. He expanded on research for  
14 the U.S. Department of Energy and the U.S. Department of Health and Human  
15 Services; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil's career also impacted the work of the U.S. Department  
17 of State, Office of International Conferences as the International Conference Officer.  
18 Taking on this role while completing his doctorate, he served on the secretariats of  
19 fourteen international scientific and economic meetings and treaty negotiation  
20 sessions, best known was the UN Conference on Law of the Sea. He was also  
21 employed full-time in the State Department Bureau of Public Affairs; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil's education has enhanced his career to reach and  
23 captivate the minds and intellect of thousands of individuals. His professional career  
24 is built on his academic degrees in: Bachelor of Arts, International Affairs, School of  
25 Public and International Affairs, George Washington University; Graduate Studies in  
26 Political Science at Fordham University; Master of Arts in Public Administration,

1 School of Government and Business Administration, George Washington University;  
2 Doctor of Philosophy, Political Science, George Washington University, in areas of  
3 specialization in International and Comparative Politics and served as a Research  
4 Fellow in the Institute for Sino-Soviet Studies; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil is also an author in thirty-nine books, peer reviewed  
6 Journal Articles, book chapters, Invited Articles and Declassified Reports. He is in  
7 preparation with a completed manuscript of *Seven Big Questions: An Introduction to*  
8 *Comparative Political Thought*. He has presented nineteen Select Research  
9 Presentations as Author or Co-Author; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Stoil is a member of several professional organizations in the  
11 American Political Science Association from 1978 to 1984 and 2006 to the present,  
12 and was co-founder and first program Chairman of the APSA Conferenc Group on  
13 Government and the Arts; Midwest Political Science Association from 1978 to 1982  
14 and 2008 to the present; and the International Studies Association from 2005 to 2012;  
15 and

16 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Michael J. Stoil will now enjoy the benefits of retirement in  
17 caring for his family, namely his mother and wife, Carol and will continually be  
18 supported by the love of his children Jacob Stoil and Rebecca Stoil Shimoni; now  
19 therefore, be it
