WHEREAS, Mrs. Amelita E. Nucum is a daughter of Guam and continues to live a successful and fulfilling life. She is married to Jesus M. Nucum and they have four (4) children: Jesamie; Jennifer; Jonathan and Joel. The couple also has five (5) grandchildren. Mrs. Nucum has had a successful career at the United States Naval Hospital, Guam. She is retiring after thirty-two (32) years of outstanding service; and

WHEREAS, her career as a medical professional is admirable. She is a nurse who has helped heal and support our community for several decades. She has worked at the Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) and has dedicated herself to our island.
