Flores, Janet P. Leon Guerrero, Michael C. Pangelinan, Donald C. Pangelinan, and Rosalyn P. Ochoco; and were blessed with eighteen (18) grandchildren, and twenty (20) great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Alfonso Matanane Pangelinan served honorably in the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, from 1975 to 1978, the late Honorable Alfonso Matanane Pangelinan served at the Governor's Office under the Bordallo/Sablan administration; and he had also served as Passport Office Director under the Bordallo/Reyes administration from 1983 to 1986; and retired from the Government of Guam after the Bordallo/Reyes term; and

WHEREAS, after retiring, the Honorable Alfonso Matanane Pangelinan remained active in the community and spent his time playing his bass guitar with other notable musicians, to include William "Bill" Muña, Gregorio Mafnas, Joaquin Palomo, Bill Quenga, Luis Gombar, and Danny Orfino (to name a few) at weddings, fiestas, and gatherings; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Alfonso Matanane Pangelinan was one of the original advocates for the return of *CHamoru* lands to the original landowners, and for the return of federal excess lands to the original landowners; and

WHEREAS, during his golden years, the late Honorable Alfonso Matanane Pangelinan spent his leisure time with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren teaching them how to tune and strum a guitar; and he was an avid fisherman who loved rod and reel fishing, and cooking some of his favorite traditional *CHamoru* dishes; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Alfonso Matanane Pangelinan was very proud of his family after having to play the role of grandfather and grandmother to his grandchildren and great-grandchildren for forty-two (42) years; and
