RELATIVE TO PETITIONING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENACT LEGISLATION THAT AUTHORIZES ONE (1) NON-CONGRESSIONAL NOMINATION WHO IS AN ELIGIBLE RESIDENT OF GUAM TO BE MADE BY THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM AND TWO (2) CONGRESSIONAL NOMINATIONS OF ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS OF GUAM BY GUAM'S DELEGATE TO THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES PER ACADEMIC YEAR FOR ADMISSION TO EACH OF THE UNITED STATES SERVICE ACADEMIES.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA*
2 *LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

3 WHEREAS, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes that Guam has among the
4 highest, if not the highest recruitment rate, highest casualty rate, and active uniformed
5 service rate per capita of any ethnic group in the United States military; and

6 WHEREAS, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes that the People of Guam have
7 continued to demonstrate their love and loyalty to the United States, to the Marianas,

1 and to preserving democracy throughout the world; and

2 **WHEREAS, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*** recognizes that the United States Delegate
3 to the House of Representatives is authorized to appoint one (1) Congressional
4 Nomination to the Department of Defense Service Academies; and

5 **WHEREAS, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*** recognizes that there is legal precedent that
6 authorizes a Governor from a United States territory one (1) Non-Congressional
7 Nomination to the Department of Defense Service Academies who must be a native of
8 that United States territory; and now therefore, be it

9 **RESOLVED, that *I Mina'Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*** does
10 hereby, on behalf of the People of Guam, request that the United States Congress enact
11 legislation that establishes that the Governor of Guam be authorized one (1) Non-
12 Congressional Nomination to each of the four (4) United States Department of Defense
13 Service Academies who is a resident of Guam; and be it further

14 **RESOLVED, that *I Mina'Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*** does
15 hereby, on behalf of the People of Guam, request that the United States Congress enact
16 legislation for Guam's Delegate to the United States House of Representatives be
17 authorized to nominate two (2) eligible candidates who are residents from Guam per
18 academic year for admission to each of the United States Service Academies, namely,
19 the United States Air Force Academy, United States Coast Guard Academy, United
20 States Merchant Marine Academy, United States Military Academy at West Point and
21 United States Naval Academy; and be it further

22 **RESOLVED, that *I Mina'Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*** recognizes
23 that the number of persons admitted into America's finest military training academies
24 only builds upon the decades of demonstrated loyalty to the United States, ability,

1 bravery, intellectual capacity, and perpetual commitment to preserving democracy
2 throughout the world by *I Taotao Tano*; and be it further

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Legislature Secretary attest to, the
4 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable
5 Michael F.Q. San Nicolas, Delegate, United States House of Representatives; and the
6 Honorable Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, *I Maga'Håga Guåhan*; and to each of the
7 respective public and private high schools on Guam.
