4 League of Guam or YMLG, is the oldest *CHamoru* fraternity on record having been
5 incorporated March of 1917 in order that *CHamoru* men may engage in social
6 discourse, moral and physical development, and elevate the status of young men on
7 Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS,** *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan* fought for and successfully secured
2 the support of the Honorable Woodrow Wilson, President of the United States, in
3 order that the league’s founding members may congregate, engage in peaceful
4 enterprise and in the exercise of free thought; and,

5 **WHEREAS,** The preamble for the *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan* states “for God
6 and Guam, we associate ourselves together to promote fellowship, closer
7 understanding among fellowmen and to inculcate a sense of individual obligation to
8 God and country”; and

9 **WHEREAS,** The first officers of the *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan* were Leon
10 Flores, President; Jose Duenas, Vice President; Manuel Ulloa, Secretary; and
11 Adriano M. Cristobal, Treasurer. The YMLG’s Librarian was Vicente Arriola; its
12 Sergeant of Arms, Y. Aflague; and its Sports Manager was Manuel Franquez; and

13 **WHEREAS,** *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan*, under the leadership of Johnny
14 Taitano, President; Andrew Laguana, Vice President; Frank Mesa, Secretary; and
15 Victor Paulino, Treasurer; continues to advocate, promote and preserve the
16 *CHamoru* culture; and

17 **WHEREAS,** *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan* continues to serve and provide support
18 to our island through scholarships, social activities and civic events with the support
19 of fifty (50) active and engaged members; and

20 **WHEREAS,** *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan*, further supports public education,
21 government sponsored events, natural and man-made disaster recovery, cultural and
22 religious events such as fiestas and Liberation Day festivities; and

23 **WHEREAS,** *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan* continues to support the Ladies
24 Auxiliary which empowers and promotes equality among women within our society;
25 therefore, be it

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of I *Mina'Trentai Singko Na*
2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on of behalf *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and of the
3 people of Guam extend its congratulations to the *Inetnon Lalahen Guåhan* on the
