WHEREAS, Angel is the husband to Cristina Valdez Marquez and proud father to Kristine Soliel Marquez Emmanuel, Dr. April Karen Marquez-Herrera, OD and Kurt John V. Marquez; and

WHEREAS, Angel started working at Guam EPA in January of 1985 under the Water Pollution Control as Engineer II; and

WHEREAS, He was promoted to Engineer III under the Safe Drinking Water Program in February 1988 then getting promoted to Engineer Supervisor in 1991; and

WHEREAS, Angel was the Manager of the Safe Drinking Water Program since 1991 to the day of his retirement; and

WHEREAS, He was periodically appointed to Water Division as Acting Chief Engineer; and

WHEREAS, During those times at Safe Water Drinking Program, Angel was responsible for the revision of the Safe Water Drinking Regulations, which adopted the required Federal Regulations in order to maintain Safe Drinking Water Primacy for Guam; and

WHEREAS, Angel initiated the promulgation and enforcement of the Guam Lead Ban Act in which Guam now enjoys being a lead-free island; and

1 **WHEREAS**, For the past 13 years Angel taught review classes for Guam's
2 Water and Wastewater Operators in which the passing rate increased from 10 -
3 15% to 50 – 60%; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Angel was instrumental in the revision of the Guam Safe
5 Drinking Water Act after almost 42 years of no revision as required by law and
6 revised since it was first adopted in 1976; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Angel was also instrumental in providing imperative
8 information to USEPA Region IX for the Stipulated Order issued to Guam
9 Water Works Authority (formerly PUAG) in which a major improvements and
10 remarkable changes for GWA for a better, reliable and dependable Water
11 System; now therefore, be it
