BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN:

WHEREAS, I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that to assure that the voices of the community are heard and that actions are not halted for any unnecessary purposes, that it is critical to establish reasonable timelines in the referring of legislation from the Committee on Rules to the appropriate Standing Committee; and

WHEREAS, It is understood that there are many factors that may deter the timeliness in the referring of bills, including the awaiting of a fiscal note from the Office of Finance and Budget or a legal review of the legislation, however these technicalities can still be attained even after the bill is referred, and it shall be the responsibility of either or both the bill's author or the Chairperson of the Standing Committee to follow up with in attaining to assure the bill moves along the process;

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1	WHEREAS, All bills introduced involve the efforts of research, time spent or
2	drafting, reviews, conversations, and contain discussions with stakeholders, that not
3	taking any action on pursuing the legislation further, especially if it involves either
4	unnecessary reasons or political purposes, is an injustice to the community, the prime
5	sponsor and cosponsors, and the legislative process in general; and
6	WHEREAS, Nothing in this resolution mandates that all legislation be
7	scheduled for a public hearing or that all bills be referred to a session agenda, but
8	rather it establishes a clear policy that respects the interest of sectors of the community
9	which is imbedded in the legislation while also promoting a more transparent
10	legislative process; now, therefore be it
11	RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'trentai Singko Na
12	Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people
13	of Guam, amend Section 6.01(d) of RULE VI-PROCESSING OF BILLS of the
14	Standing Rules of the I Mina'Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guahan to read as
15	follows:
16	(d) Bill Referrals. After introduction, the Chairperson of the Committee on
17	Rules shall refer bills within ten (10) working days of introduction to the Committee
18	having the subject matter jurisdiction to which the bill most pertains (the "Principal
19	Committee"), as determined by the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules subject to
20	ratification at a meeting of the Committee. A bill shall still be referred to the
21	appropriate Committee while awaiting a fiscal note from the Office of Finance and
22	Budget or a legal review from the Legislative Legal Counsel. Once the fiscal note or
23	legal review is complete, they can be submitted to the referred Standing Committee.
