He graduated from the Guam Community College Vocational High School Program in 1986; and continued his education and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Public Administration in 1996 and subsequently a Master of Public Administration degree in 1998, both from the University of Guam, as a recipient of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Professional Scholarship; and he had also earned a Certificate in Government Financial Management; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Suguitan retired on September 30, 2019 after thirty (30) years of service in the government of Guam. He has served as a Planner for the Guam Coastal Management Program and led the program's research, advocacy, and championing of Green Infrastructure (GI) and Low Impact Development (LID) technologies and their implementation. Through extensive networking and collaboration, Mr. Suguitan worked to identify best practices at the local, regional and national levels to promote and expand the adoption of GI and LID; and




