WHEREAS, *National Apprenticeship Week* is celebrating its fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) year anniversary, and the Guam Department of Labor, in conjunction with the Guam Contractors Association, will host the 2019 Guam Registered Apprenticeship Forum - *LET'S GET TO WORK - HIREGUAM!* held on November 12 and 13, 2019 at the Dusit Thani Guam Resort, featuring keynote speaker Kayleen McCabe, a general contractor, television host and marketer, who will speak about the success of apprenticeship programs and careers in the various trades; and others, from the apprentices to journeyman-workers, will share their success stories; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 Guam Registered Apprenticeship Forum will focus on the Guam Registered Apprenticeship Program (GRAP); the Guam State Apprenticeship Agency's expansion grants; how it can further business development; how the Guam Department of Labor Apprenticeship Office can develop and support apprenticeship programs on Guam; and the creation of apprenticeship programs in non-traditional occupations; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Registered Apprenticeship Program, the highly successful public-private partnership that incentivizes professional development for local workers by subsidizing through tax credits up to half of approved training costs, has been extended by five (5) years to 2024 under Public Law 35-39, which was signed into law by Governor Lou Leon Guerrero on October 14, 2019; and

WHEREAS, in addition to extending support for the GRAP, Public Law 35-39 expands the list of careers and companies eligible to participate, modernizes the administration of the law, and provides for a sustainable funding source, all for a program that provides an opportunity to help build a homegrown skilled workforce, help more people find good careers, and help more companies invest in employees who show promise; and

WHEREAS, the apprenticeship programs provide tangible value to both employers and apprentices, with the potential to increase productivity, improve diversity and inclusion, and reduce recruitment and training costs while providing a pathway to prosperous careers for job seekers; and hundreds of Guamanians receive training each year that allows them to enter careers such as accounting technicians, automotive mechanics, carpenters, cooks, electricians, sheet metal mechanics, telecommunications specialists, and ship builders through public-private investments and partnerships; and apprenticeship programs are proven pathways toward thousands of sustainable and fulfilling careers in diverse industries, such as information technology, healthcare, energy, aerospace, construction, advanced manufacturing, hospitality, and financial services for millions of Americans; now therefore, be it






