**Relative to recognizing Mr. Joseph C. Quinata, RPh, for his outstanding service to the people of Guam; and to congratulating him on the occasion of his retirement after forty-six (55) years of dedicated, professional, and exceptional service to the Government of Guam.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:**

**WHEREAS**, Joseph C. Quinata, who is originally from *Umatac*, resides in *Santa Rita*, with Josephine, his wife of fifty-one (51) years; and

**WHEREAS**, Joseph pursued his education and, in 1964, earned his high school diploma from Father Duenas Memorial School in *Mangilao*, Guam; in 1967, received his Associate Degree in Science from St. Gregory's College in Oklahoma, USA; in 1969, received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Biology from the University of Guam in *Mangilao*, Guam; and in 1972, his Bachelor of Science Degree in Pharmacy from the College of Pharmacy at the University of Oklahoma; and

**WHEREAS**, after graduating from high school, Joseph began his profession as a pharmacy aide, where he was known as the "water boy" at Guam Memorial Hospital while still attending classes at the University of Guam; and

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1       **WHEREAS**, in July 19, 1973, Joseph received his Pharmacist License from the  
2 Oklahoma Board of Pharmacy and returned to Guam to serve its people from 1973 to  
3 1985, as Director of Pharmacy at the Guam Memorial Hospital; and

4       **WHEREAS**, Joseph continued his pharmaceutical work in the private sector by  
5 owning and managing Perezville Pharmacy from 1985 to 2003, serving as a Pharmacist  
6 at the Kmart Pharmacy from 2003 to 2010, and serving as the Pharmacist-in-Charge at  
7 the Sagan Amot Pharmacy from 2010 until his retirement; and

8       **WHEREAS**, Joseph served his community through his commitment as the  
9 Chairman of the Guam Board of Pharmacy for Examiners, receiving accolades for this  
10 service; and

11       **WHEREAS**, with the retirement of Mr. Joseph C. Quinata, RPh, the people of  
12 Guam are losing one of the most talented and dedicated medical professionals and the  
13 administration and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* would like to wish Joseph well, and thank  
14 him and his family for their endless sacrifices so that the people of Guam could live  
15 better and healthier lives; now, therefore be it

16       **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Singko Na*  
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
18 of Guam, recognize Mr. Joseph C. Quinata, RPh, for his outstanding service to the  
19 people of Guam; and congratulate him on the occasion of his retirement after forty-six  
20 (55) years of dedicated, professional, and exceptional service to the Government of
