3	WHEREAS, Jon A. Anderson was a familiar media personality to the					
4	residents of Guam and Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Island (CNMI);

6	WHEREAS, He first moved to Guam in 1977 to become Vice President					
7	and General Manager of KUAM for several years before he became one of the					
8	founding partners of the Sorensen Media Group, which was formed in 1980 as					
9	K-57 Radio Inc; and					
10	WHEREAS, to many island residents on Guam, Jon Anderson will be					
11	greatly missed and remembered as the person serving as the host of the popular					
12	K-57 "Breakfast Show" for over fifteen years; and					
13	WHEREAS, Jon Anderson anchored the first television news broadcast of					
14	the Pacific News Center, the news program that was formed under Sorensen					
15	Media Group. Additionally, during his time at Sorensen Media, Jon served					
16	as the General Manager, along with corporate executive, as the company					
17	expanded to the CNMI.; and					

- WHEREAS, after leaving Sorenson Media Group in 2006, Jon brought
 his work to Bridge Capital LLC in Guam and Saipan; and
- WHEREAS, in 2010, he was named Editor-in-Chief of the Marianas
 Variety Guam Edition and would lead the Marianas Variety news team until his
 retirement in 2014; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Jon Alan Anderson dedicated decades of his life to bettering
 7 the lives of the people of Guam through the development and improvement of the

 immense public service to the people of Guam in keeping us informed, engaged,
 and included in important matters to the well-being of Guam; and
