2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Myers is a dedicated and committed hard working
4 individual who has served in the Government of Guam for eighteen years; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Myers will retire from the Department of Public Works Office
6 of Highway Safety on June 30, 2020, having served a tenure of fifteen years as a Data
7 Control Clerk II at the department; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Myers is a 1977 graduate of George Washington
9 High School, a former resident of Asan and currently a resident of Yigo; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Myers began her government career in August 28, 1978
11 at the Agency for Human Resource Development where she served as a Clerk II
12 for one year; and at the Department of Public Safety (Guam Police Department)
13 where she initially served as a General Helper, EDP Machine Operator
14 (Electronic Data Processing Machine Operator) and then reclassified as a

1 Computer Operator II, a tenure of two years at the department. Ms. Myers' final
2 public service in the Government of Guam is with the Department of Public
3 Works Office of Highway Safety as a Data Control Clerk II for fifteen years; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Myers is assigned to the Traffic Records Information
5 Management program, where she has performed beyond her responsibilities as a Data
6 Control Clerk, having the expertise in data collection and acquired expertise in basic
7 computer technology; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Myers attained national credential as a certified child
9 passenger safety technician and has conducted child seat inspections to ensure children
10 are secured properly in the right car seat. She has also assisted in educational outreaches
11 for various highway safety campaigns such as Distracted Driving, Driving While
12 Intoxicated, Speed, Occupant Protection, and Pedestrian Safety. Ms. Myers is
13 recognized and commended for her participation in highway safety programs and the
14 team that effectuates changed behavior for greater highway safety for our community
15 now, therefore be it
