help others, stems from the cultural values of his home island of Moch; and									
WHEREAS, Mr. Rhaym moved to Guam in 1995. From 1998 to 2019 he found									
himself working in the ocean at the Alupang Beach Club. He assisted tourists and other									
patrons with various marine activities including parasailing and dolphin watching.									
Water safety was always his primary concern; and									

WHEREAS, in 2019, after over ten (10) years at the Alupang Beach Club, he

sought out employment at Jeff's Pirates Cove. Mr. Rhaym holds with him First Aid and

1 CPR certifications as well as basic training in a pool setting. With less than one year 2 employed with Jeff's Pirates Cove, Mr. Rhaym has already responded and saved one 3 life; and 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Rhaym plays a vital role on the Jeff's Pirates Cove's rescue team. He is one of the main "go-to guys", when responding to distress calls. Rayhm and 5 Douglas Phillip are the dynamic duo who are sent directly into the rough waters of the 6 7 Togcha channel.
