





1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** The University of Guam's Center for Island Sustainability (CIS)
4 was established in 2009 by President Emritus Dr. Robert A. Underwood to lead and
5 support the transition of island communities towards a sustainable future; and

6 **WHEREAS,** CIS has since become a focal institute in our region for adapting
7 and modeling technologies to meet island needs in the broader areas of the environment,
8 economy, society and education; and

9 **WHEREAS,** for the past decade, CIS has hosted its annual Regional Conference
10 on Island Sustainability; and, for this Conference this year, the theme of "Sustainable
11 Then. Sustainable Again?," recalls our island's past as a sustainable society and asks if
12 and how we can be sustainable again; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the 10th conference will continue to encourage action to achieve
2 sustainability, not only because it is the right thing to do, but because it is the smart
3 thing to do; and

4 **WHEREAS**, decreasing reliance on imports, improving energy independence,
5 and increasing food security all reduce the export of money and build a thriving local
6 economy, more resilient to disasters and global changes; and

7 **WHEREAS**, UOG's newly appointed President, Dr. Thomas W. Krise, hosted
8 another gathering of island university and college presidents to learn each other's
9 experiences, strengthen their connections, and build an identity for island universities
10 as a unique segment of the higher education universe; and

11 **WHEREAS**, a robust program of pre-conference workshops, keynote speakers,
12 plenary panels, breakout sessions, site visits, and an Island Sustainability Community
13 Night, provided conference participants with a valuable exchange of knowledge, ideas,
14 tools, and solutions to move ahead and take action on sustainability in their
15 communities; now, therefore be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Singko Na*
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
18 of Guam, recognize the University of Guam Center on Island Sustainability for their
