## BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Robert M. Guzman, a son of *Guåhan*, who was born on March 4,
1963, resides in Santa Rita with his wife, Lorraine P. Guzman, and their three (3)
children, Jhon, Robby, and Ryan; Robert is the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) of seven (7) siblings; and

6 WHEREAS, Robert graduated from high school at the Guam Community
7 College (GCC) in May of 1981. He enlisted and served four (4) years in the U.S. Army
8 as an active military service member from September 1981 through September 1985.
9 Robert then enlisted in the Guam Air National Guard in November 1985 and retired in
10 March 2016; and

WHEREAS, Robert joined and graduated from the Fire Academy at GCC in 12 1989. Robert started his career in the Guam Fire Department on May 15, 1989. He is 13 the only one in the Guam Fire Department to serve twenty-nine (29) years and eight (8)

months—almost thirty (30) years, consecutively—before retiring on January 18, 2019;

WHEREAS, Robert's selfless nature allowed everyone around him to prosper in their duties. Using his own resources, he would go above and beyond to make sure that in the workplace, everyone was well equipped and that the establishment was properly functioning and maintained. He instilled a sense of pride in everyone who crossed his path at the workplace as well as in the community; and

8 WHEREAS, Robert's commitment to his duties and to the community as a first 9 responder in the Guam Fire Department who provided first aid treatment, life-support 10 measures, and comfort during an emergency or disaster paved the way and inspired him 11 to pursue the project of duly recognizing and documenting the information of all past 12 women and men who bravely and tirelessly served, continue to serve, and will serve in 13 the Guam Fire Department, continuing the tradition to protect and serve the community; 14 and

WHEREAS, on his personal time, Robert gathered previously unattainable information and photos of each fire cycle's graduating class to document, preserve, and archive the historical information of all women and men who willingly put their lives on the line to protect the people of *Guåhan* in service with the Guam Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Robert researched extensively and personally endeavored to make sure all names and photos he gathered were documented and framed. His archives date back to the First (1<sup>st</sup>) Fire Cycle in 1977 through the Twentieth (20<sup>th</sup>) Fire Cycle in 2014, and he eagerly awaits completion of the Twenty-First (21<sup>st</sup>) Fire Cycle's graduation to acquire pictures and names of graduates; and

WHEREAS, Robert is continuously working to gather information of the women 1 and men who served prior to 1977, when the Guam Police Department and Guam Fire 2 Department fell under the auspices of the enabled Department of Public Safety; and 3

WHEREAS, Robert Guzman pursued this project as a cherished personal hobby but also for the sake of historical preservation for his fellow firefighters and future 5 generations to enjoy and to connect the present with the past, in honor of those who 6 have come before him; and 7

8 WHEREAS, in his retirement, his physical absence is noticed at the fire stations, but his love for his fire service family is now etched in the hearts of those he has inspired 9 and those he has mentored. Because of his giving nature, unselfish ways, and his 10 positivity, he is fondly described as geftao by those closest to him; and now, therefore 11 12 be it
