6 firm that helps freelancers and small business owners learn about finances, as well  
7 as Hell Yeah Bookkeeping which seeks to provide business owners with the best  
8 possible bookkeeping experience; and

9       **WHEREAS**, Freya Estreller is the co-founder of Cool Haus, an artisanal  
10 dessert company as well as the Head of Operations for Tea Drops, founder and CEO  
11 of Ludlows Cocktail Co., and cofounder of Future Gin, an all women distilled,  
12 distributed, and owned spirit brand; and

13       **WHEREAS**, Megan Villa is the cofounder and Creative Director of Svn  
14 Space, a platform that focuses on harnessing hemp for a variety of uses, in addition  
15 to being the founder of Mini and Maximus, a children's clothing brand, and the
