

She started working at the bank in 2011, and through perseverance and working long days and through school, she still managed to finish her baccalaureate.



**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** Si Yu'os Ma'åse for all of the testimonies. It was important to be able to hear you highlight some of the things like your degree in business administration and I think even your anti-money laundering skill, it speaks to your detail-oriented ness or nature and maybe in some ways perhaps so with what PBS will be working with as they're dealing with large corporations perhaps, or if they move in the direction of being the Guam Film Office, I think that there are many ways that your skills that you highlighted, not only your degree in training but some of the other roles that you've played we have the potential of really being assets.

So, as you listed you've been participating in many organizations and I really think that speaks to your ability to serve on a board for our community. Because it does take time... And then not only were there the two testimonies we heard today for your support, but there were others that were sent to my office and they note things such as... that you willing to go above and beyond that you're very positive, you were very

dedicated, you're a hard worker, you have a high level of integrity and under other such qualities that are important for all of us to hear in the Legislature as were determining your nomination.

Those are important things for us to hear as characteristics that you would be bringing with you. One of the things that I noted is that in one of the testimonies they mentioned that you were born in Saipan. So, this is not really a fully in the side... I think that it is related. How many years did you spend on Saipan before you came to Guam or was it just a very short time that was there?

**MS. BEATRIX ALYANA O. NAHOLOWAA:** Less than a year... Probably... that I move straight here. Yeah.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** Okay, but you know I think considerations like that can have a certain amount of importance, if you will, just in that like with Miss Carrillo was saying that PBS KGTF they're here to serve Guam and the Micronesian region. And I think in the many ways that many if not all of our community members are connected with other places. It helps us remember that we have that greater Identity or that greater role in and to the like PBS and KGTF where they're serving not only Guam but Guam within this larger context and so perhaps in some way that helps you remember just that were within that broader context as a possibility.

Other characteristics that were mentioned by those that provided support is they noted that you're intelligent, charismatic, committed and that you're very passionate about education and that last one really was important for me to read as well because a very important function of PBS is that it is out there educating in many ways our youth and keeping the community informed. And so, I think that those are also potentially skills that you could be bringing with us that understanding about education.

A typical question is we always want to make sure that our board members talk about and recognized any conflict of interest they may have. Do you see any conflict of interest at this point?

**MS. BEATRIX ALYANA O. NAHOLOWAA:** No Madam speaker. I do not have any conflict of interest being, as a board member.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** Okay, and then if in some way or another, something arises... how would you proceed if you felt that there was some sort

of conflict? Somebody you knew maybe, somewhere that you've worked for before, if that came up?

**MS. BEATRIX ALYANA O. NAHOLOWAA:** I will do my best to have integrity and to serve well and to always do what is right.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** Si Yu'os Ma'åse, that's good to hear. As I mentioned before I've gone through quite a few of the things that different people have highlighted and you yourself have highlighted. So you bring quite a bit to the table I believe and the only other question that I have for you is whether you have any thoughts on something that you particularly like to focus on if you have any visions for... maybe a direction that PBS KGTF could be going in?

**MS. BEATRIX ALYANA O. NAHOLOWAA:** I believe a vision I have with PBS is to really enhance the educational tools and to me personally as a former kindergarten teacher, I believe that you don't learn only in the four walls. You learn everywhere and there's always something new to learn and learning is an everyday experience. Like even me personally, I'm learning new things every day, so what I would like to do with PBS is to really try to hone in using social media or technology to really grasp the attention of youth and their peers.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** *Gof mauleg,* that's very good to hear. It is a strong part of what PBS provides and any way that they can be continuing to expand that I think is going to be a plus for our community. One of the things I guess we'll be seeing is the what different ways that they may be growing. I've heard I believe that there may be growth in our children's programming. And so again that may be something that fits in very well with some of your strengths that you bring.

So, with that unless there is something that anybody else wants to add?
