#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 10:10A.M.

Acting Chairman Clynton E. Ridgell: All right welcome back I like to continue now the other portion of the hearing with the appointment of Christopher Cruz. Mr. Cruz please join us at the front as well as anyone who's come here to testify on Mr. Cruz's appointment, I believe some of the names we have signed up here include Patricia Salas, Isa Koki, Francis Cruz and Ana-Alicia Cruz so if anyone would like to provide oral testimony please join us at the front all right let's begin now with Miss Koki

Isa Koki: Håfa Adai Senator Ridgell, Senator Terlaje, good morning my name is Isa Marie Cruz Koki and I am here in support of Christopher A. Cruz's nomination to serve on the Guam Ethics Commission. I have known Chris my whole life as he is my first cousin, we grew up more as siblings than anything else as we are both only children, we attended the same elementary and middle school we were watched by grandparents every day after school and in our adult years we found ourselves working for the same employer at Bank of Guam as the eldest grandchild of Jose and Dolores Cruz he served as a positive role model to me as well as to all my cousins he is intelligent passionate highly analytical and strong-willed I've always known him as someone that does the right thing and is thorough when making decisions he opposed the values of respect honesty and integrity he doesn't back down from a fight when he is fighting for something, he believes is right and Chris is currently a relationship banking manager at Bank of Guam in his position he takes care of some of the bank's most important customers this role requires him to uphold high ethical standards as there are many opportunities for unethical behavior to occur expensive gifts can be exchanged for loan approvals personal bribes for better fees or rates non-business expenses classified or hidden as business-related however Chris has been able to flourish in this role due to his impressive portfolio and relationship skills that are both fair and profitable he upholds the highest professional integrity and his moral compass is intact prior to being a relationship baking manager he was a branch manager in Pohnpei where he was adored by the community because he took care not only of the business means but of the people he was a vested member of the community and showed compassion for the people and their Island. Chris is also an active member in our community he is a member of the Rotary Club of Pago Bay and an active parishioner of Our Lady of Peace and safe journey Church in Chalan Pago where he serves as a Lecter a Eucharistic minister and the fundraising chair of our parish council, he is a devoted husband, father and son he value's family and his faith I have known Chris - always been one to rise to the challenge and I'm certain he welcomes the opportunity to serve the people of Guam with arms wide open he's a good fit for this commission he will bring with him his experience of sound analytics and thorough decision-making and his principles of integrity and honesty thank you for your.

Acting Chairman Clynton E. Ridgell: Thank you Mr. Cruz?

**Christopher A. Cruz:** Thank you – good morning Senator Clynt Ridgell and Senator Teresa Terlaje, thank you for having me this morning again my name is Christopher A. Cruz (**SEE WRITTEN TESTIMONY**)

**Acting Chairman Clynton E. Ridgell:** Thank You Mr. Cruz for your testimony Senator Terlaje do you have any questions for the panel?

**Senator Therese M. Terlaje:** Thank you, thank you for your testimony Lisa and Thank You Mr. Cruz, say I appreciate your testimony also and your acceptance of this nomination if I can I just ask did you did I hear you correctly that you said he was highly unpolitical what did you say about.

**Isa Koki:** I did not I believe I said highly ethical.

**Senator Therese M. Terlaje:** Oh, highly ethical okay I was like I've never heard that I want to know what that means okay great highly ethical great and then so Mr. Cruz yes, I appreciate your experience that and especially what you've said about Pohnpei I think Brandon will be happy to hear that he's still there, right.

Christopher A. Cruz: Yes, actually a Brandon Cruz yes, yeah, he's it he's in Kosrae right now.

Senator Therese M. Terlaje: yes, we're great.

**Christopher A. Cruz:** we work closely together.

Senator Therese M. Terlaje: well I appreciate I also appreciate Lisa's testimony pointing out how opportunity for corruption and other transgressions are available in your work and that she believes you're very resistant to those types of things and a good person a good fit for this board my only concern I guess is that we're a very small community for the past few years nobody wants to serve on this board because you know of that you're kind of having to be the judge and jury over friends these are going to be your acquaintances these might even be your business associates and you're going to have to do it notwithstanding all of that and I guess I want to just hear it from you are you are you able to do that are you do you feel like you're going to be able to resist this you know the it's embarrassing to criticize your friends sometimes and of course it interrupts relationships but I'm afraid that's what this board demands of you are you able to do that.

Christopher A. Cruz: Thank You senator Terlaje you know when the governor approached me and she asked me, you know whether I would consider you know I just straightaway told her that I would you know and I understand after talking with several people and people are looking at me like wow you're going to you're about to go on another full-time job and I said you know in my mind I was like okay you know I'm up for the challenge in short I'm going to bring my experience as a lender to be fair and impartial to what I do on this board if accepted I do it day in and day out you know in my career I have to make decisions even you know maybe not for my family my close family for example but at the end of the day I have to be able you know I have to be the one to respond to them when they ask you know for loans or anything on the banking side of things right and I always come back to again my policies always come back to my underwriting experience I really ultimately keep the best interest of the bank and of the customers wall at hand and I think that I bring that to the table here and this is definitely I mean me being like you said a judge and jury for example, for cases of dishonesty or unethical behavior brought you know to us by public servants or even elected officials you know I think that I will be able to maintain that level of impartiality and to be able to respond accordingly.

Senator Therese M. Terlaje: Appreciate that thank you Mr. Cruz Thank You Mr. chair.

Acting Chairman Clynton E. Ridgell: Thank You, Senator Terlaje and thank you to both of you for your testimony today congratulations Mr. Cruz on your appointment I appreciate the testimony from both of you with regards to specifically tying in how your experience at the Bank of Guam has helped shape your and provide evidence as to your ethics especially with regards to Miss Koki mentioning how you're in a position where people may offer you things in order to get their loans approved and she's testified saying that she believes that you are not the type to accept any gifts of that nature that may influence your decision-making so I hope you continue in that vein and encourage you to do your best and make the right decisions for everyone if you are confirmed and but I will let you know that from what I've heard so far I think you have my support for your confirmation at this point so I want to thank you for that and ask anyone else here if there's anyone else who's here to testify on your behalf please come forward if not, we will go ahead and end this hearing so the committee concludes hearing for the appointment of Christopher A.
