



PUBLIC HEARING CONVENED AT 1:05 PM SEGUED TO DONALD H. RUBENSTEIN, CONFIRMATION HEARING

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: We will now begin the confirmation hearing of *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* nominee Donald H. Rubenstein to serve as a member on the Kosas board of advisors for the Guam Museum.

I want to remind those testifying that before you speak, please make sure the microphone is on and that you speak clearly into the microphone and state your name for the record.

So we are fortunate enough here to have Donald Rubenstein. If you will begin your testimony, please thank you for coming today.

bonald H. Rubinstein, Nominee: Håfa Adai Senator. I feel very honored to be nominated to the Kosas Guam Museum board. I've been a resident of Guam for 31 years and an employee of the University of Guam. I first came here in 1988 to take the position as the three year appointment director of the Michael missionary Research Center at the University of Guam. In addition to the written material that I submitted, I just want to mention a few items in my background that are not in the written material. Museums have always held a fascination for

me. I can remember as a kid skipping school in Washington DC and taking a bus down to roam around in the Smithsonian.

When I first came to Guam, I remember the old Guam Museum and spent many visits there. I've worked closely with the Guam Museum staff in the last few years. We did a major exhibition of the artist Paul Jaqulet, and it's been a great pleasure working with them. I'm very much looking forward to serving on the board. I think there is great potential for the museum, and it is a very important and needed institution on Guam. I am happy to take any questions. I know this is a tight schedule. I don't want to duplicate material that I already submitted in writing. I'm open for any questions. Thank you very much senator.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: Si Yu'os ma'åse for that. It's a very helpful background and you point out a few things. Not everybody skips school to go to a museum. I think that speaks very much in your favor. I know from years of experience knowing you for many years and observing the work that you do especially with the Paul Jaqulet material, that you're very meticulous. You're very conscientious. You're very detail-oriented. Everything that you produced from the booklets, to the exhibit, ended up being quite exquisite and something that they could really be proud of. I believed you were also even invited to Europe? I forget the country but they were having an exhibit. I think it was France. Maybe you could speak a little bit of that experience and some of your knowledge about copyright issues dealing with artists.

DONALD H. RUBINSTEIN: Yes, you're right. That was an exhibit at the Musee Du Quai Branly in 2013 in Paris. I was invited to write the lead essay in the Museum's catalog because I had worked with Paul Jaqulet's adopted daughter when we did the 2007 exhibit in Guam. I had a chance to go through her collection that she inherited from her adopted father and to retrieve a lot of information on the Chamorro subjects who had served as models for Jaqulet's first series. The Rainbow series. We were able to retrieve the names of the individuals and publish them for the first time. When we had the exhibition in Paris, this was the first time ironically, that Jaqulet was exhibited in the country of his birth.

And as part of that exhibition, the Jaqulet state in Tokyo gave 3,000 items to the Paris Museum and we were able to get high resolution photo copies of those materials that became the basis for our Guam show. There was a great deal of adherence to proper copyright and acknowledgement. We worked with Jaqulet's copyright agency in New York.

This is an issue which is relevant to any museum exhibit to acknowledge copyright and fair use. Thank you for that very complimentary introduction.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: My pleasure, definitely. In looking through some of the material you provided and then of course, for knowing you for quite a long time as well, you have worked as a postdoctoral research fellow at the University of Hawaii. You've been a visiting professor in Germany. You've been a visiting researcher in Japan. You've been out here for the last 30 years. One of your special focuses if you will, has been studying Micronesian culture, Pacific culture and other parts. I know you've looked at Art textiles. I just see that you bring so much of this background, experience and knowledge with you, that I think you would really work very well at Kosas. Is there anything you know about the body of advisors?

Where do you see a particular focus that you'd like to be working on? Or a particular need maybe? Do you know some of the members already who are there?

DONALD H. RUBINSTIEN, NOMINEE: Yes, I have worked with Dominica and of course with Monica and Clifford in the Galaide organization. I have visited all of the major areas of Micronesia and watched the development of the new Yap Museum. I've donated some material to them and I think that one potential avenue for future development for the Guam museum, is to link more closely with the regional museums in Micronesia. To work with them and with the Pacific island Museum Association to develop criteria and cataloging techniques that can aid the whole region. Maybe perhaps working towards sharing and circulation of materials and exhibits. I think that this is an exciting time in the region because several areas are working to construct or rebuild their museums. There is a Yap Historical Museum that is now moving into a second phase to develop a temperature humidity controlled facility. Palau has two excellent museums. Their National Museum and the Private Etpison Museum. In the Marshall Islands, the Alele museum is trying to resurrect its program after some financial problems over the last 10 years. I think that this is a very good time for the Guam Museum to position itself working with these other Regional organizations on common concerns.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: I think you've outlined that very well and it really helps us understand what's going on in that region. The fact that you can do that at a moment's notice with the simple question, again, really defines what you're bringing with you at the possibility of being a board member of the advisory body. In looking through the

material that you provided, you served for many years with the faculty Senate at the University of Guam serving as President and Vice President. You were with the faculty Union. You served for many years as board member with the Guam Humanities Council board. I think it's very important for us to know that part of your background. One of the things that we've seen over the years is that many boards are never able to function because they're not meeting quorum.

I think that really signals to us that you understand the commitments that are involved. The time that you have shown yourself, you've already demonstrated that. If you accept something, you will be quite committed to that. Do you foresee any conflicts of interest?

DONALD H. RUBINSTEIN, NOMINEE: No, I do not foresee any conflicts of interest in my taking this position on the Kosas board. I would like to thank you for noting some of the background on my written material. I would say that probably the activity at the university that has given me the most personal reward, has been teaching in the Micronesian studies program. I'm particularly proud of our graduates. As you know, as one of our graduates, we have produced what I see is the next generation of leadership on the island. I have served on the thesis committee and chaired the thesis committee since 1994. When the program first started, that was a real source of pride and pleasure for me. Thank you.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: Si Yu'os ma'ase for bringing up some of those issues. And it's true. As a Micronesian studies graduate student, that is where I first took some of your classes and I got to know the extent of your knowledge and the responsibility that you feel to a community. I think I learned a lot about both of those aspects from you and one of the things that has always meant a lot to me was understanding your commitment to a community. That was something that was really impressed upon me.

I will also mention and perhaps you'd like to talk about it a bit, I do think it's important that you noted that connection. In fact, I was just having a conversation a little bit earlier today about how sometimes in our island communities, we can get these great gaps. Those that are serving in certain positions in specialized positions, in museums, in our other cultural agencies and offices. If we're not active with the universities institutions or just as a community keeping that in mind, it can be 10 20 30 years that were not cultivating the next generation. I think that you have those things in

mind, and you will be a very good connection between the museum and what goes on at the University. They also have the Hita program. This amongst other places that are the responsibilities that the advisory board can bring, I think that there may be something that you can bring to that as well. Helping them build on what has proved to be a very important part of what the museum offers. Having specialized studies or others in the community that have certain knowledge or certain experiences and bringing that to the community. Have you had any thoughts on the Hita program? Those evening lectures or afternoon lectures that they do sometimes?

DONALD H. RUBINSTEIN, NOMINEE: Yes, I did give one Hita lecture in conjunction with the Jaqulet exhibit. I've attended a number of them. I think they're very useful. I am proud to see people from the University taking part in those and I would like to see a closer relationship between our University and our Guam Museum. I've worked with the University of Guam Isla Art Gallery since I first came to the University of Guam in 1988. I've been on their Board of advisors since that time and I've curated three exhibits at the Isla Gallery. I think that there's a lot of potential for collaboration and cooperation between the Isla Art Gallery the University of Guam and the Guam Museum.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: I like what you outlined very much. I agree with what you're saying. There is a lot of potential for collaboration on the island. We do have these different entities like Isla that the museum can be collaborated more. Then also these Regional institutions, specific institutions and beyond but I know that they have some really interesting aspects to their collections that they have that connected history or shared history in some way or the other or similar cultural traits and material culture. I think that certainly there's a lot to be gained by us continuing to explore those Avenues. So thank you for all of those points that you've been making. If there's nothing further that you'd like to add.

Anyone else who has not testified who wishes to testify. I know that the head of the Department of Chamorro affairs would be testifying here, but she's off island in Hawaii right now helping us prepare for Fest pack. She's there doing that. This concludes the confirmation hearing for Donald H Rubenstein to serve as a member on the Kosas Board of advisors for the Guam Museum.
