general that they were void to begin with.

On Tuesday, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities voted to release all audio recordings of the executive session in which pay raise discussions took place.

The motion carried with four votes in favor and one against. CCU Chairman Joey Duenas was the sole dissenting vote. The recordings covered salary discussions for power and water utility personnel, executives and lawyers, and the CCU board secretary. There was

also discussion on leave hours, but a decision on that matter was reserved for a different meeting.

There was mention of public perception throughout the executive session discussion.

GWA General Manager Miguel Bordallo did not want a pay raise, according to Duenas. However, Duenas did recommend that Bordallo's pay be increased to \$200,000 annually – Bordallo was making \$175,000 at the time. Sanchez had some reservations about the hike. Meanwhile, Duenas also recommended a \$25,000 bonus to GPA General Manager John Benavente,

who was making \$225,000 at the time.

He said both general managers had been doing outstanding jobs at their respective agencies.

"How about we pay Miguel a one-time bonus," Sanchez said. "I think it looks better for us when the pay stays the pay and you just give them a bonus."

Guthertz, referring to GPA, said it would look better to the public if there were an actual raise to salary rather than a bonus check to Benavente.

"That's going to raise hell," she added. Public perception," Guth Sanchez, reverting back to GWA, Commissioners also agrees aid he was more comfortable with a \$25,000 bonus for Benaven

one-time bonus for Bordallo.

Santos, who is Bordallo's brother-inlaw, noted pay in the private sector is tied to performance. This is when the discussion on performance evaluations took place.

"I'm for giving (Bordallo) a raise because we haven't done it in three years," Santos said.

The commissioners ultimately agreed on increasing Bordallo's salary to \$190,000 plus a \$10,000 bonus.

"I think that would look better, too. Public perception," Guthertz said. Commissioners also agreed on the \$25,000 bonus for Benavente.

Hello, My name is Dr. Arania Adolphson, I am here today for a confirmation hearing regarding member appointment to the Guam board of Medical examiners.

I would like to provide a summary of my professional background. I was born and raised in Seattle, Washington. I decided at the age of 12 to enter the field of medicine. At the age of 17 I was admitted to Brown University's Program in Liberal Medical Education as an Early Decision applicant. This was a combined Bachelors and Doctor of Medicine degree which I completed in 2003 while I was concurrently serving in the US ARMY Reserves as a Chemical Operations Specialist. After completing 8 years of study in Providence, Rhode Island I moved back to Seattle for my Family Medicine Residency at Group Health Cooperative of Puget Sound. While I was a medical resident I learned to Scuba dive. After completion of my 3 year family medicine residency in 2006 I decided to continue my passion for scuba diving in my first job placement. This is how I landed in Guam in 2006. I learned about Guam through a professional placement business—It sounded exotic, it sounded remote. It sounded analogous to my work in Roatan, Honduras where I volunteered at a non-profit rural clinic as a Resident. Little did I know I would come to call Guam my new Home.

I worked 2 years at Pacific Medical Center then started working at American Medical Center in 2008 under Dr. Hoa Nguyen and Dr. Vincent Akimoto. At American Medical Center I currently work as a primary care and sports medicine physician. I previously maintained hospital privileges at Guam Memorial Hospital from 2009 to 2016 where I provided care for AMC's hospitalized patients. While at GMH I served on the hospitals' credentialing committee. The credentialing committee's task was to review new applications for hospital admitting privileges and renew the privileges of existing physicians. This activity is similar to the charge of the Guam board of medical examiners.

In 2014 I became involved with the Guam national olympic committee and attended the 8th Micronesian games as the team physician for Team Guam. I have enjoyed working with the GNOC athletes and since then have provided side line and training room physician coverage at several international competitions.

Due to the special medical needs of athletes I decided after the 2015 Pacific Games to gain extra medical education to learn how to better serve the athletes of Team Guam. I studied for

one year at the University of Las Vegas and received my certificate of added qualification in sports medicine. I have continued to be involved with Guam's athletes and last year attended the Youth Olympic Games in Argentina with our wrestling delegation.

The public hearing was called to order at 1:05 PM. Chairperson Therese Terlaje presented the agenda items that would be heard during the hearing. The appointment of Dr. Arania O. Adolphson to serve as a Member of the Guam Board of Medical Examiners was the first item on the agenda.

Chairperson Therese M. Terlaje:

Håfa adai. Thank you for coming everyone. It's good to see you all here.

So, we will begin with the appointment of Dr. Arania O. Adolphson, Dr. Adolphson as a member of the Guam Board of Medical Examiners.

Thank you doctor for being with us today. Before we hear your testimony. I would just like to read the duties of the Guam Board of Medical Examiners as stated in Title 10 of our Guam Code.

The Board of Medical Examiners shall have the following powers and responsibilities:

- (1) promulgate rules and regulations;
- (2) select and administer licensing examination(s);
- (3) evaluate medical education and training of applicants;
- (4) evaluate previous professional performance of applicants;
- (5) issue or deny initial or endorsement licenses;
- (6) approve or deny applications for license re-registration and renewal;
- (7) receive, review and investigate complaints;
- (8) receive, review and investigate reports received from law enforcement agencies, health care organizations, governmental agencies, insurers and other entities having information pertinent to the professional performance of licensees;
- (9) issue subpoenas, subpoenas duces tecum, administer oaths, receive testimony and conduct hearings;
- (10) discipline licensees found in violation of the Medical Practice Act;
- (11) institute actions in its own name and enjoin violators of the Medical Practice Act;
- (12) establish appropriate fees and charges to include support of active and effective pursuit of its legal responsibilities;
- (13) re-instate revoked license at its discretion, but to use such discretionary authority in a consistent manner and with great assurances that the re-instatement of a license will not jeopardize the public; and
- (14) develop and adopt its budget.

(15) receive, review and investigate a peer review finding and action received from a health care organization pertinent to the professional performance of a licensee. Upon the receipt of an appeal of a peer review finding and action.

We will now accept testimony from Dr. Adolphson. Please proceed doctor.

Dr. Arania O. Adolphson:

Please see attached testimony.

Chairperson Therese M. Terlaje:

Thank you very much Doctor. There's also a Joey Miranda, if I read that correctly who wants to testify. Did you want to testify? Or just here for support?

Alright. Thank you very much.

Dr. Adolphson, if you don't mind. First I want to thank you for accepting this nomination and of course your service to our community since 2006 and especially to the Olympic Committee since 2014 and the work that you've done.

I agree it seems very compatible and with the work that you will be doing on this licensing board. I think we're very lucky to have you here on Guam. So thank you for that. Good thing for scuba diving. Lucky for us.

I'm going to ask you some questions now for the record. Do you have any continuing business or potential conflicts of interest that may affect your ability to serve in this position?

Dr. Arania O. Adolphson:

No, I do not, Senator.

Chairperson Therese M. Terlaje:

Will your current work schedule affect your ability to attend regular board meetings and perform the duties required of the members?

Dr. Arania O. Adolphson:

No.

Chairperson Therese M. Terlaje:

There have been complaints brought recently regarding Medical Malpractice Mandatory Arbitration Act, a law that's passed on Guam and how we deal with lawyers and complaints against them. The concern is that the mandated process places a huge financial burden on persons making claims and that it's cumbersome and puts limitations on due process.

I guess I'm just asking you in advance if you have any thoughts about this process and as you begin your work on this board.

Dr. Arania O. Adolphson:

The mandatory arbitration can help to perhaps clarify hurt feelings or misunderstandings that may have happened in the care of a particular patient and I think that is a good thing when it comes to prior to initiating litigation.

However, I do understand that sometimes it can limit settlement amounts. For that I would have to have more investigation and learning about that topic.

Chairperson Therese M. Terlaje:

Thank you.

Do you think Guam's medical licensing minimal requirements which allow physicians to practice on Guam need to be improved?

Dr. Arania O. Adolphson:

I think they are analogous and similar to the states. Some states do have more requirements specifically fingerprinting or like a FBI background check but some states do not.

Chairperson Therese M. Terlaje:

My understanding too is that we've maybe in a couple years ago if not last year joined or passed the law that would allow for that mutual program across different jurisdictions mutual licensing program but they haven't implemented it yet.

So I think that's something that the board would have to do but I think it's been authorized. So maybe and if I understand correctly also that fingerprinting and FBI background checks are part of that process, if they choose to do that.

All right. I appreciate your testimony. I appreciate your thoughts on these matters and I appreciate your openness to investigate further and see what we can do to improve healthcare on Guam. That's our ultimate goal.

And there being no other questions. I want to thank you again for your willingness to serve on this committee.
