II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Kelly Marsh (Taitano), Ph.D., Chairperson of the Committee on Heritage and the Arts, Parks, Guam Products, *Hagåtña* Revitalization, Self Determination, and Regional Affairs, presided over the *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*'s nomination-public hearing of **Dr. Carlos Madrid Alvarez-Piner**, to serve as a 'Member' of the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority, Board of Commissioners. The May 22, 2019, public hearing was convened at 10:10am, ending at 11:20am.

Items on the Agenda include the following:

- **10:00 AM** Confirmation Hearing of **Rita T. Franquez** to serve on the Board of Commissioners, *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority.
- 10:30 AM Confirmation Hearing of Patricia Ann P. Ada to serve on the Board of Commissioners, *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority.
- 11:00 AM Confirmation Hearing of Eduardo J. Calvo to serve on the Board of Commissioners, *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority.

The public hearing was called to order at 10:10am.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PHD., CHAIR: Committee on Heritage and the Arts, Parks, Guam Products, *Hagåtña* Revitalization, Self-Determination, and Regional Affairs now convenes this public hearing. Public hearing notices were given to the media. The first notice was on Wednesday, May 15th, 2019. And, the second notice was on Monday May 20th, excuse me, yes, the second notice was on Monday, May 20th, 2019 for the record; today is

Wednesday, May 22nd, and the time is now 10:10 am in the morning. Notices sent out for this morning's confirmation hearing include the following; confirmation hearing of Carlos Madrid to serve on the Board of the Commissioners, *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority; confirmation hearing of Patricia Ann P. Ada, to serve on the Board of Commissioners, *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority; and, Eduardo J. Calvo A...huh, J. Calvo sorry, to serve on the Board of Commissioners, *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority.

The confirmation hearing of Patricia Ann P. Ada, to serve on the Board of Commissioners for the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority, Committee....scheduled for to 10:30 am, will be postponed and rescheduled to May 30th, 2019. Miss Ada advised the Committee that she is off-island. The Committee attempted to coordinate today's hearing via video teleconference, which the nominee accepted. However, she is currently in transit and a robust internet connection at the Chuuk Airport could not be located. The Committee will continue to accept written testimonies. And in fact, I have one here already on Mrs., excuse me, Miss Ada's nomination.

Joining me for this public hearing will be Senator Telo Taitague. And, I will now go over the general rules for the public hearing. The conduct of this public hearing shall be as follows...those testifying will be recognized in the order of the sign up, on the sign-in sheet. We may make an exception at the beginning since we do have, Mr. Carlos Madrid on teleconference. Written testimony, may be read. Lengthy written testimony should be summarized to about five minutes. Written testimony shall be submitted to the Committee. Please provide our legislative staff with your written testimony for photocopying. Testimony shall be confined to the substance meaning to the topic of the hearing. Persons will be allowed to present oral testimony only once. Once you are finished you may be asked to remain in the room for questions; or, for additional testimony as may be desired by the members of the panel. When you speak please make sure that the microphone is on. Tele-conferencing not included; and, that you speak into the microphone. Please state your name for the record before you begin your testimony.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PHD., CHAIR: Next we haveso with that, next we have the confirmation hearing of Mr. Eduardo J. Calvo, to serve on the Board of Commissioners for the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority. We have several people here that are here to provide testimony. We have Mr. Ricardo Duenas who is providing oral testimony. If you could go ahead and come forward. We have Mr. Calvo who we will be listening to; and, then we have the executive director of the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority, Lasia Casil, who is also here to provide written testimony and oral testimony as well. So, with this...being physically present, the confirmation hearing will go ahead and hear from your supporters and then we'll save your testimony for last Mr. Calvo. So, if we could begin with Mr. Ricardo Duenas, and if you could begin your testimony with stating your name.

RICARDO DUENAS: Si Yu'os Ma'ase yan håfa adai, Madam Chair and Senator Taitague. My name is Ricardo Duenas and I am here this morning to provide testimony and support Eduardo Jake Calvo, to service on the Board of Commissioners for the Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority. I've known Jake practically my whole life and I'm older than him. So, I can say I've known him his whole life. We have a familial-ties together and I have always known Jake to be intelligent fair and an open-minded individual. Now granted, he's not a historian, but he is an accomplished businessman and I believe the skills...he brings to the Commission as a businessman, will serve in the...in moving forward with the goals of the of the Authority. From a personal perspective, I think Jake has a history and a love and affinity for the village of Agana, and that Affinity is born from his personal history not just himself, but also his family. His family have been longtime residents of *Hagåtña*, dating back to the late Spanish, the pre-war and the post-war eras. Personally Jake, I know Jake like myself, attended the Cathedral grade school in Agana. His family has had been longtime parishioners of Agana Cathedral. And so, I know from my experience, Jake spent a lot of time in Agana. Growing up climbing the trees of the Plaza de Susanna, along with my brother; and, roaming the streets as he waited for his father to get off work, in his office here being here in Agana. So, I think Jake provides a unique perspective as a longtime resident of *Hagåtña* that although may not be as a professional historian....brings the personal and familial connection with the Island with Agana. And I think those skills will be useful when we move forward with the goals of the authority and I believe that Jake, will serve as a very valuable member of the Commission. Thank you very much.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PHD., CHAIR: Si Yu'os Ma'ase for your testimony and for taking the time to come here today and you bring forward very good point. If we had a Board that was only comprised of let's say historians; and, we would be a very one-dimensional Board. So, what we're looking for ideally is a Board that's comprised of engineering skills, planning skills, architectural skills, cultural heritage skills, historian...and so, I think in that way all together, we are bringing all of those perspectives all of that expertise.

All together to best figure out the way forward and the best way to be considering as many important aspects as possible. Certainly, the familial connections are important as is, you know, having that continued connection with $Hag\mathring{a}t\tilde{n}a$ and business skills are important as has been brought up earlier....finding funding. We do hope that the, or...are planning to revitalize Agana in a way that it's going to be a business district along with a living district as well. And so, those kinds of considerations I think, have their role within the Board. So, with that, we also have Ms. Lasia Casil. If you can go ahead and begin your testimony as well.

LASIA CASIL: Håfa adai again. Thank you. And for the record again, my name is Lasia Casil. I'm the executive director of the Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority. I'm here to testify in support of Mr. Jake Calvo to our Board of Commissioners. I don't know Jake personally. I've only met him a couple of times. But I do know, that he has a very strong background in business administration and has been a part of one of the anchoring, as the gentleman stated before, businesses and families here in Hagåtña that has helped build up and

create our capital city. I was looking through his...his nomination packet and something that really stood out to me was his...his focus on compliance, you know, in his background. And, we had just talked about that before. So, I was thinking, you know looking at our Board and you just stated it yourself, was how will this, you know, what strength this will bring to our board...that of a well-rounded Board. You know, we have historian, we have a business owner, we have residents. Ms.Franquez was...who has lived in Hagåtña of pre-war post-war and...and, compliance is definitely something that we're going to need with all of the 31 projects...possible projects; and, all the moving parts that comprise this entire huge effort. We're going to need you know, that...that detailed of keeping projects in line. And I think, that's one of the strains that...that Mr. Calvo has. Looking at his packet and I know that our governor has faith and confidence in him...have spoken with her about this. So, as I do hope that you will consider Mr. Calvo for the Board. Thank you.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (**TAITANO**), **PHD.**, **CHAIR**: Si Yu'os Ma'ase for your testimony and for bringing out some of his strengths such as perhaps having that very detail-oriented perspective, which does make a lot of sense, if we're going to have a large number of projects occurring and they're going to be occurring for a long period of time. We definitely need very detail-oriented people. I would say so, with that, let's go ahead and here for him. Mr. Calvo himself. Si Yu'os Ma'ase.

EDUARDO J. CALVO: Buenas yan Håfa adai Madam Chairwoman and Committee members. Thank you for the opportunity to testify on my nomination to serve as a Board member on the Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority, Board of Commissioners. It's an honor and privilege to be considered. Living on Guam, we all know Hagåtña as our Capital it is the home of our seat of government Judiciary and spiritual passed historic photos show Hagåtña as a vibrant and populist Village the center of our Islands social Civic business and government activities.

Hagåtña means much more to me. My family's connection to Hagåtña spans many generations. My grandparents Eduardo Torres Jake Calvo and Veronica McDonald Calvo were residents of Hagåtña prior to World War II and even before they were married my father and his brothers spent much of their youth in her gut Nia according to Precious old photos and stories. My grandmother would tell when my grandfather first started his first started his insurance business. He did so, from his home in Hagåtña behind the current Hagåtña police precinct later. He relocated Calvo's Insurance offices across the current bank of Guam building.

Calvo's Insurance is still headquartered in *Hagåtña* on the entrance of challenge Santa Papa Street. Calvo Enterprises Incorporated is just walking distance down Martyr Street. I understand *Hagåtña* as the original home to our heritage and even the gateway to our future.

The HRRA has done great work to revitalize *Hagåtña* the right way and I'm honored to have the opportunity to join the HRRA to help continue that work. Visiting different capital cities over the years impacted my perspective of those countries in a profound way witnessing the development

in Manila from the 70s to now has been on inspiring from Malacañang Palace to Rizal Park to Salcedo Market, a special energy unique to Manila abounds here.

Experiencing Tokyo through the years both as a tourist and a resident expanded my perspective on how a modern society maintains its cultural identity. Both these capitals for me, represent a great balance of modernization and cultural tradition. The recent developments of the Guam Museum and the Guam Congress Building in *Hagåtña* are proof that Guam's capital is thriving while seeking to maintain a similar balance of the modern and the traditional.

Hagåtña Master Plan is a timely idea for our island's Capital. The restoration and development of Hagåtña stands to benefit our community. As a whole, it would be an honor to work in tandem with our fellow stakeholders in the island's business Community, to continue the mission of the Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority to revitalize, promote, preserve, protect, and protect the Heritage and economic vitality of the city of Hagåtña. Si Yu'os Ma'ase for the opportunity to testify.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PHD., CHAIR: Si Yu'os Ma'ase for everybody here....for testifying and it's very good to hear your....your testimony. Part of what stood out to me is just; and, I think it's because I've had similar experiences in visiting other capitals. It opens up your eyes to different possibilities and I do think that's important to be very grounded in home. But to also see different ways that different these different areas are tackling some of those same issues. How do we move forward with development modernization but balancing that with tradition and all those special things that have made that place a home or something special to people for so, long. So, with that I will turn this over to Senator Taitague for her comments and questions.

SENATOR TELO TAITAGUE: Thank you Madam Chair. And Madam Chair, I've known Jake for quite some time, unlike Dr. Madrid where my questions were extensive...because I didn't know very much about him. I do know Jake, and he definitely...definitely has my support. I wanted to be here today to also include some of the...the nice things that Mr. Duenas has said. There's so much more to this guy. He's an artist. Number one... and that kind of experience can bring so much to *Hagåtña*. In fact, I think Jake you still play music in *Hagåtña*. You decided to keep your gigging here and *Hagåtña* instead of Tumon. And I'm so, glad you did. You know, there's not a lot of music down in this area and you're keeping that alive. So, that perspective, you know; music does so much to a community. And, it brings people together, and fills your heart with joy and great ideas and being positive. So, you're going to bring that to the board. You know, your experience with music but most especially you know, the one thing that's important, is your love for *Hagåtña*. That speaks bounds. I mean that goes beyond any experience anybody has; or ,what that brings to the table...your love for God. Yeah, it's truly there. I also know that you're a very...very honest person. Like Mr. Duane has said to....and, very compassionate. So, I have total confidence knowing that somebody on this Board is going to be there with all those attributes. It's so, important, and as I meant into Dr. Madrid, the concern of funding. Well if anybody knows business, it's you Jake, you know, you can bring a

lot. I mean Lasia, this guy can move mountains, you know, and it's not just his influence in the business community but his compassion and his personality. You know, I would write a check for you Jake anytime. If you came up to me, you have that way of influencing people and...and in a good way to, you know Madam chair. I just, I commend the governor for making such...such a great choice to sit on this Board because I have an interest and I've always had an interest in her $Hagåt\tilde{n}a$ Restoration from the very beginning when I was actually part of the implementation of the plan or the creating of the plan as I mentioned with you Lasia. So, Jake you have my full support and I ask my colleagues to do the same as well. Thank you so, much for stepping up to the plate because I know you've got a lot on your plate and to do this...is...it's to our advantage. Thank you...to Guam's Advantage. Si Yu'os Ma'ase Senator. Thank you.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (**TAITANO**), **PHD.**, **CHAIR**: So, I have just a few questions. We'll go ahead with a question...question that I had asked previously you are a business owner. I saw that in your resume' and it's been spoken about . Do you...do you foresee any conflicts of interest and if so, how do you plan to approach those?

EDUARDO J. CALVO: Thank you for that question Senator. I don't foresee any business conflicts not with the businesses that I'm personally that I personally have interested.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PHD., CHAIR: I did like hearing, or I do think it's an important thing for the Board of Commissioners. I hadn't realized that you are a musician but I agree with the previous apparently a very good one and I agree with the previous Senator that...that's an important attribute to bring with this revitalization of *Hagåtña* we're looking for it to be this place that is engaging to our locals. It's engaging to...tourists. It needs to be vibrant. It needs to be active. We want people to be coming here often. We want them to be having these excellent experiences and we need that creativity in the way that we're approaching architecture, the development of the park areas.

You know all the different places that we can be expressing it and be putting that creative eye to it. So, I think that's a very important skill that you bring. One of the things that we're seeing now is how these murals are going up in $Hagåt\tilde{n}a$; and, it really changes the ambiance of what $Hagåt\tilde{n}a$ feels like amongst other things that are happening, food trucks and other things. I think that these are all very important to creating the kind of energy that this plan is...is looking to continue to build on so, that was very good to hear, and your business acumen will be bringing strength as well.

Now, the next question that I have and I'm going to apologize for it ahead of time because I have some lengthy exposition and then I finally get to the question. So, I apologize for the lengthy exposition.

EDUARDO J. CALVO: No apologies necessary.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PHD., CHAIR: Our community needs Commission members who understand...and know how to or are willing to appropriately listen to and respond to data about our society culture and environment and the relevant issues associated. Our community also needs a Commission that understands and knows how to address....just the realities of our landscape that we have a new Administration with its own vision of how to develop for the future. We have new directors of our government agencies who are bringing with them perhaps different expertise and sets of experiences. And, that there is this rapidly changing face of how government agencies are to incorporate issues that we're all getting to better understand like climate change and sea level rise and the negative impacts that our environments societies and indigenous cultures; and, the negative impacts on our environment societies and indigenous cultures. If we don't change the way that we develop and interact with our community such as to updating *Hagåtña* a sewage treatment plan. Just a few miles away. We are having the Port Authority renovate the hotel Wharf to accommodate the cruise ship industry. And, the Coastal Zone Management Program has discussed severe issues with the concept of building a cruise ship port in Hagåtña owing to unacceptable environmental impacts and conditions. However, at the same time we are all interested in moving forward and making things happen in Hagåtña. We've been planning this a long time. We all definitely want to move things forward. So, thus the Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority needs a Board of Commissioners who pay real attention to these types of data, and these changing Regulatory and other developments. So, finally you can question.

Do you see yourself as someone who will appropriately listen to and report...respond to such data and issues and work to resolve them. And then, if you could explain perhaps the ways that you foresee being able to deal with those changing situations over time. Like new understandings about our environment new understandings about ways to as a government agency....to deal with environmental and other issues.

EDUARDO J. CALVO: Thank you for that question. Yes, I would I would definitely respond, but I would also like to...to defer to the group as well that we...it wouldn't be me personally and responding I would...I would consult with...with the rest of the Committee members and you know, pull our resources and defer to the experts as well. Because obviously, I'm not..my area of expertise is not in an environmental issues.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PHD., CHAIR: That's very reassuring answer. I feel experts are experts in their different areas for a reason. It's always good to have a critical eye even with experts and taking into consideration the group that I think is also important but you also speak to a skill which can be very important in issues like this because this...is a long-term plan. It's going to take perhaps 20-30 years to implement. Perhaps we'll never finish.

It's work in a sense because we'll always be wanting to modernize and develop and rethink things. I mean, that's just how society operates and so, paying attention to those things is

important because we do want to move forward and we just need to work together problemsolve, figure out the best path forward and then make it happen, right so!

I have one fortunately shorter question much less lengthy exposition beforehand assuming that the plan is adopted. What is your vision for how it will be implemented over the next 20 years given that as we just discussed things are going to change over time.

So, do you have any recommendations on a formal mechanism for periodic review of the plan and its implementation by agencies outside of the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority. So, just focusing on...any thoughts on a formal mechanism for periodic review of the plan and its implementation.

EDUARDO J. CALVO: Thank you again for that question Senator, I would simply just just focus on what can be done. Now. What is realistic now, for example, be it a building and that whether there's property that the government already owns and *Hagåtña* if that can be if development can that can be started on that. Let's work on...on what's on the Here and Now!

Si Yu'os Ma'ase for answering that and I think going back to your earlier answer where you were saying that you are open to listening to experts maybe even as a as a Commission member calling for expert experts to weigh in or provide their perspective in any time that you feel that it's important to do. So, I think that those are going to be important and we do want to move forward. So, a certain amount of what we're doing does it does have to be in the now yes, and then maybe it's more so, for us as policymakers to be thinking about that periodic review and...and how to ensure that it happens. So, everything is staying current and people are like within the Board of Commissioners able to focus on the now while those of us up here maybe are the ones who are just making sure that everything is staying current and all the agencies are working together and it stays on track in the best way possible for all of us.

The community so, are there any further comments or questions?

So, again Si Yu'os Ma'ase everyone for your testimony and for taking the time this morning, it's been very important and very enlightening to hear from everyone.

So, if there's no not yet, if they're not any others that wish to testify the confirmation hearing of both. Mr. Carlos Madrid and Mr. Eduardo Calvo, to serve on the Board of Commissioners for the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority is...is now completed...and the Committee...I want to remind the public that the Committee will be continuing to receive testimonies for the next few days.
