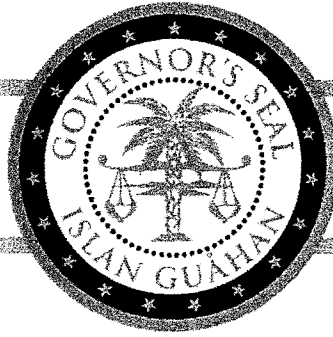





I think it's, um, it speaks volumes that you're passionate about, about serving on the Board and, you know, you've been re-nominated by the Governor and I, you know, thank you so much for your, your acceptance of the nomination and you know, you, I don't have any questions. So just, thank you.

Ms. Fisher: Thank you, ma'am.

Chairperson Perez: So, I would like to pass the, the floor to any of my colleagues who would have any questions. Senator Castro.

Senator Castro: Just briefly, Madame Chair. First of all, thank you so much, Ms. Fisher, for accepting the nomination. I see that your life partner is also in the room, and if family support is indicative of your character and willingness to give your time, voluntarily, to serve the people of Guam. I know the Aguon family and, and you're in good company. I just want to, this is kind of a departure from I nor—how I normally handle nominations and my commendations to individuals. But I want to encourage you as, as a Member of the Board. While I, I tend to vote in favor of stricter controls when looking at alcohol or other types of controlled products, for the sake of protecting our children, I do want to stress that, from my perspective as a responsible consumer, responsible adult, and member of this community, that I think the onus is on the business owners and those who procure these types of products to be responsible in the use and disposition of those products. I'm not a big fan of stronger government controls and regulations, so I want you to, I want to encourage you to look at it that way and not what the, through the, through the lens of being much more punitive on our small businesses or medium-sized or even large businesses, but to look at the individual owners and encourage them to be law-abiding citizens and judicious in their way. I'm way out of the clubbing scene, but I, you know, I've been informed that it's not the

Ms. Fisher: Um, so, I was deployed in February and then I've not been able to attend any Board meetings until I get reappointed, officially. So, but, prior to that I was the Board Secretary, so I was in charge of the minutes, post-all our meetings.

Senator Taitague: So, you haven't had a chance to look at the latest meetings?

Ms. Fisher: Not recently, no, ma'am.

Senator Taitague: Okay, and while you were serving on the ABC Board, were you there? Did you miss meetings, because, you know it's hard for quorum, sometimes to...

Ms. Fisher: There was one meeting that I missed but I attended by phone. I dialed in.

Senator Taitague: Oh, that's good.

Ms. Fisher: Yes.

Senator Taitague: Technology. We were just talking about that.

Ms. Fisher: Yes.

Senator Taitague: It allows you to be here, especially, you said you're a mother as well, so it's difficult holding down a job, having, you know, children, as well as, you know, working on this board. I'm glad that you took the initiative. Most people wouldn't have made that call-in, and just forget about it. So, I greatly appreciate that, as well. Do you plan, at all, visiting some of these clubs out, out here that are, you know, just looking around doing some snooping? Do you plan on doing some of that?

Ms. Fisher: Yes, so we, um

Senator Taitague: Good.

Ms. Fisher: We had that discussion because, primarily, it's the Compliance Inspectors who go out to these establishments. But my fellow Members of the Board, a couple of them have gone out to the establishments, like, at odd hours of the day because we have caught establishments staying open beyond the allowable time. And then also, to some of the vendors, we plan on actually going out either as a group, or Wednesday/Tuesday with our licenses and, just to be more diligent in the public eye.

Senator Taitague: And, you know, in your line of work, I hope that you take into mind that it's also good to be proactive instead of reactive to certain things, and you know, providing information to all these nightclubs or people looking for these licenses, you know, to give them guidance, you know, to show them how to do it the right way. And I'm pretty sure we have a lot of good people out there who want to follow the law, so proactive approach in moving forward to, it might be an idea for this Board to consider, to, passing out literature to help them understand the rules and regulations and laws of ABC. But you know, what really caught my eye about you is, well, when

you said Air Force, well, I'm an 'Air Force brat', my father, all the way. In fact, you know, he wouldn't let us marry anything but Air Force. So, you had me at 'Air Force'. Now you greatly appreciate, I saw your, your resumé here and that you previously served, and I greatly appreciate you stepping up to the plate, once again, serving the people of Guam and I wish you the best of luck, Elizabeth.

Ms. Fisher: Thank you, ma'am.

Senator Taitague: Thank you.

Chairperson Perez: Thank you, Senator Taitague. Senator Ridgell.

Senator Ridgell: Thanks, Madame Chair. First of all, congratulations on your appointment. Just one question, sort of similar to the question that Senator Taitague was talking about. You know, sort of, enforcing these rules and stuff. In particular, I'm curious to know, what do you think can be done to better prevent underage drinking? So now, Senator Taitague was mentioning, like, sort of, in the clubs and things of that nature. But, how do we help improve prevention of that? Particularly, I would say, like, in the small stores, the mom-and-pop stores. And what I'm getting at is, you know, I know you can't. It's very difficult to completely eliminate underage drinking, and there is responsibility with the parents. You know, parents have to make sure their kids aren't underage drinking. The kids, themselves, they hold responsibility. But also, there are stores I remember, when I was young and growing up in high school, I had classmates and friends that knew which stores they could get alcohol from, that would sell to them. So, how do we prevent that? How do we better prevent stores from selling to minors? I know it's not a hundred percent fail-proof. There are tricks, where you, a minor, could have a, an adult friend who's twenty-one go buy the alcohol for them. But how do we, first, just ensure that the stores aren't selling to people under twenty-one?

Ms. Fisher: So, I think preventing underage drinking is definitely a community effort and ABC Board plays a part in that. We enforce the regulation. So, in my first term, we have actually penalized and fined stores who are selling alcohol without a license. And I like Senator Taitague's idea of educating, because I think education plays a really big part, whether the community is taking a role in preventing underage drinking, or whether it's the ABC Board. But I think everything starts with the law, and we play our part in going out as much as we can, being more proactive and visiting as many places as possible. You know, resourcing with the community, like, if we hear things, to go out and actually visit that establishment if we haven't already, and our Compliance Inspectors are very, very good at that. They're very skillful at approaching an establishment and determining whether or not they're complying with the law.

Senator Ridgell: Alright, thank you.

Ms. Fisher: You're welcome.

Senator Ridgell: Congratulations again, on your appointment. And you have my support, thank you.

Ms. Fisher: Thank you.

Chairperson Perez: Thank you, Senator Ridgell. And so, this concludes the, the hearing for your nomination and I, really again, would like to congratulate you and thank you for accepting the nomination.

Ms. Fisher: Thank you.

Chairperson Perez: Yeah.

Ms. Fisher: Thank you.

Chairperson Perez: The committee will now continue to receive written testimony until 4p.m. Tuesday, November 12th. Please address testimony to myself, Senator Sabina Flores Perez.
