

Jailed Reuters reporters, US border photographers win Pulitzer Prizes

NEW YORK (Reuters) — Reuters won two Pulitzer Prizes on Monday, one for revealing the massacre of 10 Muslim Rohingya men by Buddhist villagers and Myanmar security forces, and another for photographs of Central American migrants seeking refuge in the United States.

The awards marked the second year in a row that Reuters has won two Pulitzers, the most prestigious prize in American journalism. Reuters has won seven since 2008.

Two of this year's honorees have been jailed for 490 days in Myanmar for their role in uncovering the killings.

"While it's gratifying to be recognized for the work, public attention should be focused more on the people about whom we report than on us — in this case, the Rohingya and the Central American migrants," Reuters Editor-in-Chief Stephen J. Adler said.

In other categories, coverage of mass shootings in the United States and investigations into President Donald Trump featured prominently. The New York Times and the Washington Post also took two Pulitzers each.

Reuters and the Associated Press were both awarded prizes for international reporting, with the AP winning for its coverage of war atrocities in Yemen.

The Reuters award was for an investigative report that revealed the massacre of 10 Rohingya at the village of Inn Din, in the heart of the conflict zone of Rakhine state in Myanmar.

Two young Reuters reporters, Wa Lone and Kyaw Soe Oo, both Myanmar citizens, found a mass grave filled with bones sticking out of the ground. They went on to gather testimony from perpetrators, witnesses and families of victims.

They obtained three devastating photographs from villagers: two showed the 10 Rohingya men bound and kneeling; the third showed the mutilated and bullet-ridden bodies of the same 10 men in the same shallow grave.

In December 2017, before Wa Lone and Kyaw Soe Oo could complete their story, they were arrested in what international observers have criticized as an effort by authorities to block the report. The report, "Massacre in Myanmar," was completed by

colleagues Simon Lewis and Antoni Słodkowski and published in February of last year.

In September, Wa Lone and Kyaw Soe Oo were sentenced to seven years imprisonment for violating the country's Official Secrets Act.

"I'm thrilled that Wa Lone and Kyaw Soe Oo and their colleagues have been recognized for their extraordinary, courageous coverage, and our photojournalists for their moving pictures that show humanity defying huge obstacles," Adler said. "I remain deeply distressed, however, that our brave reporters Wa Lone and Kyaw Soe Oo are still behind bars."

Assange, Manning had reason to believe leaks would injure US

WASHINGTON (Reuters) — WikiLeaks founder Julian Assange and former U.S. Army intelligence analyst Chelsea Manning had reason to believe that leaking U.S. military reports "would cause injury" to the country, federal prosecutors alleged in a newly unsealed court filing on Monday.

In the affidavit submitted to federal court in Alexandria, Virginia, prosecutors said U.S. military reports from the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq included information about the "identity and significance of local supporters of U.S. and allied forces in Afghanistan."

When U.S. forces raided the compound in Pakistan where Osama bin Laden was hiding out, for example, they found a letter that showed the al-Qaida leader was interested in copies of Pentagon documents published on WikiLeaks, the prosecutors said.


According to prosecutors, leaked reports on the Afghan war included information on militants' improvised explosive device designs and attacks, including details of U.S. and coalition countermeasures against such home-made explosive devices and their limitations.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Perez called up the appointee and those who signed up to testify.

Brian Bamba, IT&E: My name is Brian Bamba and I'm here to testify in support of Mr. James Oehlerking's nomination to the Guam Solid Waste Authority Board. I've had the pleasure of knowing Mr. Oehlerking for about four years. We sit together on an executive team of our group. Companies where his input is quite valuable, and he heads up IT&E, which is one of our group companies. I think that he's a great nominee and he would be a great addition to the Solid Waste Board. He's run not only our local company here with over 300 employees covering the geographic region throughout Guam and the CNMI. He's also has experience as a senior manager or director of a multinational. I think that's important to consider his views and his perspective on very complex issues that we face as a community. I know that he's only been here for a short time of four years. He and his wife have become very rooted in our community, as much as placing themselves here, acquiring a house, and calling Guam home. I have no issues with his commitment

to resolving and contributing to resolving our issues in solid waste. I hope that you consider his nomination favorably and I'm here to support him as well. Thank you.

Steven Carrara, IT&E: Hi good afternoon my name is Steven Carrara. I work at IT&E, as well as group of companies Mr. Bamba works for as well. I've known Jim Oehlerking for several years. He runs IT&E. I work with them daily. We address many complex issues. Jim likes to get to the bottom of things and get things done. It's solid waste. I'm a bit of a pack rat myself. We had a lot of old electronics gear that wasn't used, and we were able to ship three containers off island get it recycled in an environmentally friendly way. It's very conscious on his mind. Our group supports public service. I've been on EPA board for several years and when Jim arrived on-island he was anxious to serve on a board. I'm glad this opportunity came up and I support his nomination. I think the community would benefit from his involvement on the board. Thank You.

James I. Oehlerking, Nominee, Guam Solid Waste Board of Directors: Thank you Senator. As I've said I'm Jim Oehlerking. I am chief executive officer of IT&E. My wife and I have been here for four years. We bought a house down in Pago Bay and now called Guam home. At a company were highly involved in charitable and community support activities, but I've been looking for opportunities at a personal level to give back and make a contribution. Prior to my four years of running IT&E, I was with Motorola for 27 years. I've got a wide operations base background with program management and project implementation, as well as a significant solid business background. I think the challenges and the opportunities with Guam Solid Waste. Looking for an effective, efficient in long-term sustainable solution, for Guam, I think is critical. I would look forward to the opportunity to make it a contribution to that activity for the island of Guam.

Chairperson Perez: Thank You Mr. Oehlerking and thank you for accepting the Governor's nomination. So just I just want to remind the public. The mandate of Guam Solid Waste Authority is to oversee a solid waste management system, at a time when receivership is about to end. Hopefully, after the courts hearing or that's what the intent is of the judge. In the current talks that we've been having, that's the direction that we're moving. So, this is a very critical time to be. To serve on the board. A lot of decision-making is in play, in regard to the future of Guam Solid Waste Authority, as under the control of the government. In order to ensure proper cost-effective, environmentally sound disposal of solid waste, while lessening the demand for the landfill sites, conserving our land resources, and ensuring that no health risk to human plant and animal life. So, given that, what do you see as your role in this transition or transition period?

Mr. Oehlerking: All right, I think the key points of my contribution would be in the next generation of cell that needs to be contracted and constructed from an operationally. From a board oversight perspective and looking at the overall program management implementation and cost-effective implementation of that project, but also on the conversion and moving out of receivership. Chairperson Perez: So, you are CEO of IT&E? Do you foresee any type of conflicts being a CEO and serving on the board of Guam Solid Waste Authority?

Mr. Oehlerking: No, I'm both on a professional and personal level. The business responsibilities at IT&E really do not conflict with any of the activities, that I can see associated with Guam Solid Waste Authority, and I also have no personal involvement with any businesses associated with Solid Waste.

Senator Taitague: Thank you Madam Chair and thank you so much for stepping up to the plate. I remember when you first came to Guam I was with the Governor's office when we met. I appreciate everything you've done with contributing to the various charities that assisted Guam. One of them I think, was a Rigalu Foundation. We appreciate that for foster children. Thank you so much and you know the only thing I can think of it's just time. You're a CEO of a big company here. It does require a lot of your time and as well as time spent off-island, as well. My concern is to ensure that you're there at all the meetings.

Mr. Oehlerking: I have spoken to Andrew Gayle. Also, as far as the time requirements, and it is something that I looked at seriously, because time is a challenge. In the four years I've been here I wouldn't have been ready now. I've sort of got the business operating at a level that I feel I've got the bandwidth to give back. Commit some personal time to activities like this.

Senator Taitague: Okay, well I appreciate and thank you for stepping up to the plate. Thank you, Madam Chair.

Chairperson Perez: Thank you Senator. Thank you very much again. I feel that you have a lot of expertise that can complement the others on the board, that are currently serving. We have somebody who's expert in management of Human Resources. We have a Peggy Denny. We hope to confirm this session, and Andrew Gayle who's been there at the helm, for the time of the receivership. He brings a lot with him. A lot of institutional knowledge. We look forward to seeing you there as well. Thank you so much.
