So one of the problems that we face right now is actually do you know if we have the numbers required for further you know board members at the contractors on board because I've been informed several times that we need to expedite this assignment because there's no quorum and people are applying for Contractors License and things like that do you think with you coming in do you think we meet that to have a you know the sufficient numbers of board members? So that we can have a quorum every time you know we go on a hearing or the contractor some license board going a hearing and they meet the numbers of members think we have that with you coming in?

**James Casallo:** Yes Senator. Actually what happened was when we did the transition to the new Administration that was the bottleneck and right now we have resolved about new and renewals for contractors. We resolved about 900 more or less contractors that applied for their licenses.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** So we have an outstanding number of 900 that has not been approved for their license?

**James Casallo:** No, no we had approved all the 900 already.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** Okay so most definitely then you had the required number sufficient numbers to go on with approving those license right?

**James Casallo:** Yes senator as a matter of fact we have a good what do you call this, the good set of people and very professional and actually we got Mr. - our AG's office, really supporting us at this time and also I've recruited a juris doctorate, although she's not she's not yet passed the bar I'm Guam yet she does have a JD background for being an attorney.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** You know James with your expertise and your experience being a board member of the Contractors License Board I know we've said we have some issues with H2 workers. And I don't know because I think the Governor has been pushing for that to Center the taking the required numbers of workers and you know now that we have a commission numbers of board members.

But there's one thing that I want to ask you because I used to own my own construction company, and the biggest problem that I have is going to the Philippines or going to other countries and other another other jurisdiction to get H2 workers to come in and that's the a hurdle for me, because you know when you go to the Philippines or when you apply for additional people to come in it's not that easy you know that the importation of H2 workers is dependent on the the federal law and the federal rules that they have. So do you think we still have that problem and as far as getting in a still workers into our island? Because that's I know that's a big problem right now.

**James Casallo:** Yeah I believe as far as Federal Government goes I think that's way out of my league right there. But I think we should have local talent and we should exploit our local people because a big help is the with the Guam Trades Academy they're helping a lot of you know younger folks, younger millennials try to perhaps be skillful in the construction industry.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** And you're right and you know we need to just kind of get our people on island to go to training, go to school and master the carpentry, electrical and things like that. And I think we do have that on island that Guam

Trades Academy is doing their very best to really educate these people and given that that tool to specialize in you know in construction work. So hopefully what would be a recommendation in as far as making it easier to bring in those eighths to workers? Because I don't know.

**James Casallo:** Oh gosh, I think we should just ask for the federal government to see because we are isolated on Guam. I think what I feel in my opinion is that they're saying the US federal government is saying that you know we have, they have rampant you know what they say that TNT the H2 workers that do hide in the US. But since we're kind of isolated as an island I think the federal government should open up the H2 for you know the Philippines perhaps Korea any skilled labor out of perhaps Thailand and somewhere here in Asia.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** It was also mentioned that Australia can be a part of this recruitment for H2 workers, but I don't think it's as easy as I would think. And the thing is you know when you apply for a H2 workers to come into the other to Guam right, for example because I've done this you've got a base your request for a H2 workers based on the proposed construction. So for example you have a big construction that you need to undergo you use that construction for that one particular project. So what happens if let's say that goes because the way I think about this is that when that project is done they're going to have to go back.

So what I'm planning to do is maybe initiate some kind of bill to allow those H2 to workers and to allow the owner or the construction company to use that same people not send them back and put them on another project. Because I think when you ask for for a H2 workers I think you can only mention the one project that you have that is going to be ongoing you don't mention that to tree projects that you anticipate or the number three projects a project that you anticipate you don't do that. You just concentrate on that one project.

So what's happening right now with the rule of the you know the federal rules, that when you complete that number one though first project that you applied for the

H2 worker for, when they're done with their project you can apply for additional right but that next time again so in the meantime some of these people need to go back because you know they do have a temporary visa for that. And depending on the project if the project view had mentioned your application mention that a projects going to take about a year so they'll give you they'll probably give you that one year. But after that they're going to have to go back so I need your insight and maybe you can reinforce the way they always you know what they were doing is that you've send the people back, and we don't want that that's very costly especially to the owners of the project and it was very costly to me. So what I do is you know how we use this H2 workers right and if you're running a project and maybe another person another owner of the project asks you to use some of their people, you know we let them go which is not which is not right, right? But they do that, and I know that you being a an experienced guy in construction that if your friend asked you for additional people to we'll help you out you would do that.

**James Casallo:** That's true Senator. Yes.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** But you know that's that's not right, right? That's not permitted.

**James Casallo:** I think in my opinion, I think the federal government should just open up the H2 program throughout I mean for the whole entire Guam construction industry.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** And make it up soon?

**James Casallo:** Yes I mean you know just open it up not just to federal government, perhaps the Guam government, the private sector you know because right now I see quite a few ongoing construction works and we don't really have that much skill set on our island right now it's really hard to get -

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** The specialty right that you need-

**James Casallo::** The required skill you need in Guam, like carpenters electricians, the plumbers, it's really difficult right now even for me because I do have construction work as well, and people like the construction is being prolonged it's not being completed on time so also in the case, the right now what used to be say 120 dollars a day for skilled worker is right now they're averaging averaging

about 150 dollars a day so the rate is much higher now to get a skilled person.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** You know one of the things that I faced when I used to run my own construction companies, that when you put out your plan and let's say that your projects gonna take like it may be like for one house is it usually take about six seven months about five six seven months. And you know the thing is the

owner of that construction company suffers the burden of financial ability because let's say that your project your submission of the project is for six months, and you don't finish and that that's always happening on the island because of the climate that we have the you know we have rainy season we only have two seasons rainy and and dry season and if it's dry season you're okay but if it's rainy season that will keep you back in completing the project on time as contracted right?

**James Casallo:** Yes.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** So you know we do have this problem to at least and allow and not find the owner of the construction because you know that that causes a lot of money you pay so many dollars a day if you miss so many days of not completing the project then you know you get fine for that.

**James Casallo:** Yes Senator I totally agree. Not only that, it's also a burden on to say the homeowner. Because that homeowner would have to pay a little bit more much higher I would say 30% higher to you know perhaps paid if he was building a residential home I think his loan mortgage would be much much higher. I would escalate it to be 30% higher.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** And the other problem and I know you know this and the other problem that we face in building or building a house whatever, you know some of the owners right they you go as the construction owner you go with the plan right? And then some of these you know the owner of the project, the owner of the house will say, “Hey I don't like that kind of tile”. You have to take out everything and get the nude, the tile that they want. And those they're hesitant to really if you tell them that there's gonna be additional cost for that. “Hey you know pare' we're doing the very best to finish your house oh can you give me a break.” that's us that's some of the problems that we face on this island, the owners

of the of the not the construction but the owner of the house would say, “Can you modify this I know it's in the plan but can you modify because I want this cavity to be on this side and I want the electrical panel to be on that side”. You know those are the things and I know you face those kind of problems.

**James Casallo:** Yes Senator that's true. That's that's part of where we come in and we try to resolve those issues. As part of the CLB basically we try to you

know make amends between say the contractor and the client. What I really would suggest is that they do have a written detail scope of work. Well as far as for Me, you know coming from the government. 24 years I worked with the government and then I went to private practice. I foresee and I can see those things and as far as construction then I have pretty much very well, I mean I have experience on those things.

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** Okay James I think we're gonna wrap this up, and before then I just want to thank the Governor and Lieutenant Governor for making that right choice because this the choice that they make are people that are experienced are people that knows the problem or people that can remediate and solidify the problems that we do have so I want to thank the Governor and Lieutenant Governor for making that choice and I want to thank you, thank you, thank you very much! For taking the challenge because it's not easy.

**James Casallo:** Yes Senator, thank you!

**Chairman Jose “Pedo” Terlaje:** In closing I would like to thank all of you participating in today's public hearing on Bill at 180-235 (COR) and like I said in the beginning if you have any written testimony you can send it to my to my email address 140 aspirin Aspinall Avenue Bridge Point building one nine six nine one zero but better yet because if you're going to, if I'm gonna give you my email address and they want to give you my physical address you're not gonna find my office. So better yet you know when you're going out to you know the police station down in Agana and you're going out to the traffic light to route one right after the post office that yellow building, Hava Java, I'm on the second floor. That's easier because people could be “Where is your office man?”. Okay so I said okay this let's go out there from the police station going out to route 1 and you see the
