

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education, Air Transportation and Statistics, Research, and Planning convened a Public Hearing on Wednesday, June 12, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. in the Public Hearing Room of the Guam Congress Building. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Karlyn RCG Borja to serve as a Member of the Guam Education Board, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* on April 10, 2019, for three (3) years from date of confirmation;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on April 12, 2019;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on April 15, 2019.

#### **Public Notice Requirements**

In accordance with the Open Government Law, public notices were sent via email to all senators, stakeholders, and main media broadcasting outlets on Wednesday, June 5, 2019 (5-Day Notice) and Monday, June 10, 2019 (48-Hour Notice).

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

**Vice-Speaker Telena Nelson** convened the hearing at 5:05 p.m., introduced all senators present, and announced the public notices and hearing agenda.

**Vice-Speaker Telena Nelson:** I would like to call forward the appointee, Mrs. Karlyn Borja, to the table please and any anyone who would like to give testimony on her behalf. Good afternoon. Okay, so perhaps we'll start from my left, your right, and then we'll go down the table. Please introduce yourself, state your name for the record and please give your testimony.

Mr. John T Burch (Guam Education Board) read from the written testimony that has been appended to this committee report.

Vice-Speaker Telena Nelson: Thank you, Mr. Burch.

Mr. Francis E. Santos introduced himself and disclosed, for the record, that Karlyn is his cousin. I'm very proud to be up here to offer testimony on our behalf and quite frankly, I'll take responsibility because I played an important part of recruiting her and asking her to please come and help our educational system by joining this Board. I worked closely with Lieutenant Governor Joshua Tenorio to ask her to join us and offer her services. I can speak candidly about her being a responsible and very kind and very caring mother of two very wonderful boys, and she has the challenge because they're autistic kids, and when I asked her to do this, she said, "I'm willing to do it," I was quite excited because like Mr. Burch said, it's an honor and a privilege to serve in the GDOE board because I've done it also. There's a lot of hard work that need so the put into continuing to improve the school system for our children, most especially children that need our help, so I ask for your full support to allow Ms. Borja to join this esteemed group of dedicated, I call it, that's the ultimate public service is to be on the GDOE board because you handle thirty one thousand (31,000) kids, forty one (41) schools, four thousand (4,000) employees, and it's a tough job, so I welcome her, and I ask for your support. Thank you.

Vice-Speaker Telena Nelson: Thank you, Mr. Santos. Mrs. Borja?

Mrs. Karlyn RCG Borja read from the written testimony that has been appended to this committee report.

**Vice-Speaker Telena Nelson:** Thank you, Mrs. Borja. I'll open up (for) any questions to my colleagues, we'll start with the co-chair of education, Senator Shelton.

**Senator Amanda Shelton:** Thank you very much for accepting the appointment. So, a question we ask to most of the appointees, if you feel that you have any potential conflict of interest while serving on the Board, I know that you are currently employed with a media organization. If you can just speak to what your role is there and how that (will) affect your role on the board.

Mrs. Karlyn RCG Borja: So, we actually had to clear this with my employer prior to saying 'yes' to the appointment in general. I'm actually the marketing coordinator. I'm not affiliated with the newsroom, and there are different standards when it comes to the newsroom. Also, I'm not physically in the area where the newsroom is. I am at an off-site location, so we've been vetted by our legal counsel at corporate, and there is no conflict of interest.

**Senator Amanda Shelton:** Okay, thank you very much. I appreciate that answer and what you spoke to about your role there. I know that you respect how the media can be used to play a vital role to pass out information to our public, and so I appreciate that. I would like to just hear a little more about your thoughts and priorities of what you'd like to see happen while on the board or what you think can be done to advance the department.

Mrs. Karlyn RCG Borja: That's kind of an interesting question only because there's still a lot more things to know and understand about my role on the board. I understand there is an orientation period. I'm only right now I've only been looking at what's been in the media, what's been happening in my children's schools but beyond that I'm not ready to give an answer to that quite yet. There's still a lot of things I need to find out before I can honestly give you a truthful answer as to what exactly I'm (going to) prioritize and how I'll be able to conduct myself on the board.

**Senator Amanda Shelton:** Sure. Thank you for that honesty, but I'm sure the support that we've heard here today that you're well equipped to take on those challenges and learn quickly so I have the confidence in you and I wish you the best of luck. Thank you.

Vice-Speaker Telena Nelson: Thank you, Senator Shelton. Senator Moylan?

**Senator James Moylan:** Thank you Madam Chair. Thank you, Mrs. Borja for accepting the nomination. Sometimes when you got some great people and a lot of people behind you and they really say great things about you, that means one thing. To me, it's that they can't wait for you to get to work, so I applaud you for accepting the position. I'm looking forward to the great things you'll bring to the Board. Thank you so much.

Vice-Speaker Telena Nelson: Thank you Mrs. Borja for accepting this appointment and thank (you to your) family also for coming out and showing their support. It really does take a lot of our family support that we are able to achieve our successes, so thank you family members for coming.

Vice Speaker Telena Nelson cited Subsection 30102.1 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 17 Guam Code Annotated. This is just some of the major parts right, the more politically-influenced areas that your duty as a Board member we'll have to discern on, and so especially when it comes to the budget, I implore that you take a look at how the finances are being spent and if you feel that it should be used to hire more teachers or more one-to-one aids, then I hope that you advocate for that. I'm very moved by your testimony, especially involving your sons, and so I'm excited for someone that can push a sense of care forward, for there are children (who) have special needs. It's nice to know that you're there because you have first-hand experience, so you'll be able to really advocate for them, especially the training that you've undergone. I admire that you took time off to be a stay-at-home mom which is probably not time off, so thank you for doing that. I really don't have any questions for you, but I want to thank you wholeheartedly for accepting this appointment. I'm very certain that you'll be a great advocate for the children at the Board of Education should you be confirmed. Thank you very much.
