Clement**, to serve as a 'Member' of the Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation (KGTF/PBS). The September 10, 2019, public hearing was convened at 1:05 pm, ending at 3:26 pm.

**The public hearing was called to order at 1:05 pm.**

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** The Committee on Heritage and the Arts, Parks, Guam Products, *Hagåtña* Revitalization, Self-Determination, and Regional Affairs now convenes this public hearing. Public hearing notices were distributed to the media and stakeholders. The first notice was issued on Tuesday, September 3, 2019, and the second notice on Friday, September 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019. For the record, today is Tuesday, September 10, 2019, and the time is now 1:05 pm.

On the agenda for this morning’s confirmation hearing are **Donald H. Rubinstein**, to serve as a Member on the Kosas Board of Advisors (Guam Museum); **Donovan L. Brooks**, to serve as a Member on the Board of Trustees, Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation (KGTF/PBS); **Rosemary A. Clement**, to serve as a Member on the Board of Trustees, Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation (KGTF/PBS); **Maximo P. Ronquillo, Jr.**, to serve as a Member on the Board of Directors, Guam Council on the Arts & Humanities Agency; and, **Vincent J. Reyes**, to serve as a Member on the Board of Directors, Guam Council on the Arts & Humanities Agency.

## **PUBLIC HEARING CONVENED AT 1:05 PM SEGUED TO ROSEMARY A. CLEMENT, CONFIRMATION HEARING**

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** *Si Yu'os ma'åse* for taking your time to be here this afternoon. We will continue with the nomination since we already have the next person here rather than necessarily taking a break and going into recess. As a reminder, the Committee will continue to receive testimonies for the next few days. Please address your written testimony to the Committee on Heritage and the Arts, Parks, Guam products, Hagåtña revitalization, Self-determination and Regional Affairs and submit it via email to [office.senatorkelly@guamlegislature.org](mailto:office.senatorkelly@guamlegislature.org), or to my office located on the second floor of the Guam Congress building. Let's go ahead and move into the next nomination for Miss Rosemary A. Clement, and it is 1:45.

We will now begin the confirmation hearing of *IMåga'håga's* nominee Rosemary A. Clement to serve as a member on The Board of Trustees Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation also known as KGTF/PBS. I want to mention again that there are some members from PBS, Miss Ina Carrillo, PBS station manager and Christine Flores Dela Cruz who have both come to provide their support.

So in just reading a little bit from Miss Carillo's testimony, she has very favorable testimony for Miss Clement. She points out some of your background. As I was mentioning earlier how the board, I think is served very well, by having people from various backgrounds that each are bringing some of that difference with them. She notes that you're an experienced educator. You've been living and working on Guam for over 30 years. I think you're very plugged into our

community and in those ways that you've been a lifelong supporter of PBS. That you have participated in every PBS Guam event and that you really are working towards the good of PBS; and, that is at the heart of things for you. So with that, I know that you've been here for a couple of the times; that I've gone over the procedures. I think we can go ahead and just have you turn your microphone on. Make sure to state your name and then provide your testimony.

**ROSEMARY A. CLEMENT, NOMINEE:** My name is Rosemary Alice Clement, and as you know, I am a retired teacher and definitely a lifelong supporter of public television. I grew up in New York and I remembered Leonard Bernstein's children's concerts on television when I was just a little girl; and, my whole family were big supporters. My mother and I always watched Masterpiece Theater and I think it was called something else then, but all the dramas and all that. I concur with what Donovan said about the importance especially now with television being such an influence on children and there's a lot of really bad television. I think that public television and PBS in particular, has such wonderful programs for children and not just young children, but programs like Nova and all the cultural activities. I think they're so great. I mean you can see a Broadway play on PBS. I think it's just so seriously important for our program, for our station to grow; and, Ina has done a terrific job. As Donovan said, we really want her to stay. One of our problems has been having consistency in management and as you know in any business, any activities, you really have to have consistency. One of the things she has done a remarkable job on, is fundraising which of course we desperately need for programming and for equipment in our station, which a lot of was in really need of repair. I think we were on the road more the first four years I was on the board. I think we're really a good team together. I'm just really hopeful that we'll have more local programming and more participation in the community. We do have our own read-a-thon. We have a program for children to become members. As an Early Childhood expert, if you get children when they're young then you have support for hopefully their lifetime. I must say that when I first came to Guam almost 33 years ago, one of the first things I did was to go to PBS and volunteer. So long ago the general manager was an Asian man. I don't remember his name, but I remember he sent me to Public Health for some kind of a survey. I really started right away supporting public television and continue to do so now. I don't know if you have any questions.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** *Si Yu'os ma'åse* for that. As you were speaking about some of the local programming and the Read A Thon, and some of that, it reminded me of some of the discussions that I've been hearing earlier that the board had been working together to think of some additional local programming. I don't really know about other communities. Guam's pretty much the community that I really know, but I know we loved watching our local sports and watching our kids do well in academic challenge bowl and other programs. I think the more that we're getting those opportunities to see parts of our community and people that we know, or places that were familiar with, that's going to be something really special that you guys are going to be continuing to build up.

**ROSEMARY A. CLEMENT, NOMINEE:** Academic Challenge Bowl has been going on forever. My son was on that when he was in eighth grade. I mean it's been around forever, and I think it's really popular; and, of course when you get local kids doing stuff, everyone in their family and they have millions of relatives watching it and supporting us. I'm glad you mentioned that because that is a really important program that's been going on for a very long time.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** Yes, very long. If I remember right, some of the people who were there in the very beginning were the Bothmers.

**ROSEMARY A. CLEMENT, NOMINEE:** I'm sorry who?

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** The Bothmers I think. They're an old teaching family that were here in the old days with my parents first came out. I don't recollect all the history there, but I seem to recall that they were there in those early days and some of what you were mentioning, both you and Mr. Brooks, about the type of programming that PBS offers. I've always been drawn to what it offers about historical periods and some of the programming, that I had watched a year or two or so ago, was where they walked people through these different decades and helped people understand the difference. The 1890s and the 1900s and those years that are somewhat a long time ago on one sense, but really not so long ago on another sense; and, just really getting more solid understandings of what poverty looked like, and what middle-class looked like, and what your average person on the street would look like. It's that type

of quality programming that's not just drama. It's not just these other things but it's really interesting history. I think by seeing people living through it or having people recreate parts of it so that you really understand some of those historical eras at least, that's some of what I've been drawn to.

**ROSEMARY A. CLEMENT, NOMINEE:** I think a lot of the drama on Masterpiece Theater; actually are historical and reflect in great detail what it was like. I mean you think of Downton Abbey and what the different classes were like in those days and how people lived. Call the Midwife, which became incredibly successful. It was portrayed what poor people in London were doing starting in the late 50s and it's a reflection of history. It's an intimate look at one group of people and how they we're taking care of by the midwife's. I just find that fascinating. I am a history buff and I'm really interested in that aspect as a lot of the drama is very pertinent to certain periods of history and you really get into details of it as well as straight history programs. Also, I'm very interested in the fact that there are so many cultural shows, Broadway plays, ballets, operas, dramas that people in Guam who don't get to travel very much, never have the advantage of seeing. They can see them right there in their living room. I think that's a great contribution.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** I do as well as you know, and I see that history interest run in your family. Yes, definitely. With that, I mean we've talked about local programming, we've talked about some of the program cramming that they do offer. Are there any other additional thoughts? I unfortunately had not remembered to quite ask. Mr. Brooks this question, but in the discussions that you have had as a board, are there any thoughts about directions going forward other than the ones that we've mentioned already? Or anything you'd like to talk about or just interest or potential?

**ROSEMARY A. CLEMENT, NOMINEE:** Although I am not a scientist. I know that Nova is really important and it's a way of teaching us about science in layman's terms. I think that's really important and we've had some support from the medical community and we hope to increase that support because I think that's something that's really important. Stem is so important now and I think that's one venue for us to get in contact with young people. Well anybody really, but

especially young people in high school and college thinking of careers in science and engineering, I think that's something that we'd like to have more support for.

**SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR:** *Si Yu'os ma'åse* for that. Unless there's something additional that you'd like to add to your testimony. If there is not anyone who has not yet testified, there being none. This Committee will conclude the confirmation hearing of Rosemary a Clement to serve as a member On the Board of Trustees for the Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation, KGTF/PBS. Then as that reminder, the Committee will continue to receive testimonies for the next few days.
