Resume: **Shannon J. Murphy**



Shannon J. Murphy earned a BA in communications with a minor in anthropology from the University of Guam in 1980. She went back to earn a graduate certificate in Micronesian Studies from the University of Guam in 2007.

Murphy is the managing editor of *Guampedia.com*, Guam's online resource. Some of her duties include planning and editing *Guampedia* content, supervising editorial staff, working with software designers, community partners and project scholars, as well as grants management. She has held this position since the planning phase of *Guampedia* in 2002.

Murphy has an extensive professional background in journalism, particularly pertaining to Guam and the Micronesian region.

Her roots in Guam journalism date back to her experience as reporter, feature writer and editor at the *Pacific Daily News* from 1980 to 1985 and then later as business, local news, and feature editor from 1990 to 1995. She also founded, edited and published San Francisco based *Gasetta*, a newspaper for Chamorros who live away from Guam, from 1985 to 1989. She was also the AP regional correspondent from 1992 to 1995 and the CNN regional correspondent from 2000 to 2004.

Murphy was the chief of staff for Senator Carlotta Leon Guerrero at the Guam Legislature who chaired the Legislative Committee on Transportation, Telecommunications and Micronesian Affairs from 1995 to 2000.

She then became the co-executive director of Ayuda Foundation, a regional health support organization for five years. At the Ayuda Foundation she successfully helped to create a girl's club, *Island Girl Power*, an early literacy partnering program, *Reach Out and Read*, with the Department of Public Health, as well as provide medical relief to Micronesian island residents after typhoons or other disasters.

Murphy is the daughter of well-known late Guam journalist and *Pacific Daily News* columnist, **Joe Murphy** and public school teacher Marion Murphy. She is married to Robert Wescom and lives in Santa Rita. Murphy has three children from her first marriage to artist Jose J. Babauta - Leo Babauta, Katrina Babauta Barnett and Ana Babauta – and 10 grandchildren – Chloe, Justin, Samantha, Rain, Maia, Lennon, Isabella, Seth, Noelle and Joey Lucia.

She is also the proprietor of Flores Santa Rita, a tropical flower farm next to Namu Falls in Santa Rita.

Mrs. Shannon J. Murphy: Oh no 2002.

Mr. Chairman Senator Joe S. San Agustin: Okay I see and I knew that was not right in 1902 and then I would have said that was before your dad but mame now I'll ask Senate Terlaje who's your neighbor then Senator Lee.

Senator Jose "Pedo" Terlaje: Let me just first say I want to thank our Governor and Lieutenant Governor just like I mentioned with the first group that you know the choice is outstanding we have the most qualified people that have never ever heard they are coming here today and let me just say that you know being your neighbor I know your dad, I know Joe, your brother, he's always coming to my house and say hi Pedo how are you how's work same as you it'll busy all the time but anyway just knowing that you're from Yona the daughter of Joe my good friend I'm pretty sure that for one I support your nomination and secondly you're going to be confirmed thank you and Un Dångkolo Si Yu'os Ma'åse'.

Mr. Chairman Senator Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you Senator Lee.

Senator Regine Briscoe Lee: Thank you very much Mr. Chair Si Yu'os Ma'åse' and Hafa Adai Shannon I also want to thank the governor for nominating all of the members of our the people that we hope to impanel the Guam Ethics Commission I want to thank you for accepting the nomination I know you're a very busy woman but I'm glad that you think that this is important and that you will set time in your schedule to attend these meetings and give it a lot of thought and just do due

diligence once you're confirmed hopefully I just want to disclose for the record that I've known you for decades I've known your family for decades I pretty much an or since I was about ten years old and I also wanted as close for the record that when I first decided to run for office I sought Shannon's counsel because she is somebody who I feel has the highest integrity and somebody who knows Guam very well and who I thought could give me some really sound advice when I was running for the first time so much so that I asked her to be my campaign treasurer that's how much I trust her advice and her counsel and I know that Guam is a better place because Shannon is here but I also want to say that you have a very high respect in high regard for me I shared that with you and that's why I'm going to ask you this question and I just wanted to give you an opportunity to inform the committee and the people of Guam who might be watching if you could share with us maybe an example of an ethical, ethical dilemma that you might have faced whether it's personal or professional in nature and how you were able to address and resolve this issue Challenge.

Mrs. Shannon J. Murphy: Challenge, it was what I was thinking about that because I thought you might ask then so you know working at the PDN and I'm sure all the news media we have like very strict ethical rules there you can't like eat at restaurants if you're writing a story about the new restaurant or you can't you know you're just a lot we can't go to campaign events or anything we were kept very separate from what was going on and then when I went to the legislature I work for Carlotta Leon Guerrero and we also had Nestor LeConte oh three reporters and so we were it was like really not a problem because we all were very clear about what we could and couldn't do and you know we just didn't even want to entertain but we did have some situations where people would come in and like offer us money for they were going to have a lease at the port or something like that and you know we were just all like you know couldn't believe that they would actually you know but we just like told them no that's not how it works you have to go to the board and you know we can't really influence them and so it was never a problem for us we just handled it that way because it was we're always very clear to us what was right and wrong and so it hasn't never really come up for me as a problem issue it's just yeah been easy I guess if you're trained that way in your job and also through my father was always you know treating us to making sure we knew what was what so yeah.

Senator Régine Biscoe Lee: Thank you very much Shannon, with the previous panel is something that I mentioned and I also want to mention to you it's my understanding that you will be in your first meeting should be you be confirmed you'll be kind of dusting off the you know the rules and regulations and kind of getting familiar with that and one thing that I asked the previous panel the members that were nominated to do is to just give us some feedback if you find that there might be some gray areas if you find that the law needs to be updated to include maybe information about the internet or the way that we interact with new technology anything that you might come across we urge you to really inform the legislature so we can update those rules and make sure that there are no gray areas that were very kind of cut and dry.

Shannon J. Murphy: Well one of the things I wanted to do right away was I found this epic website for the US government that was I thought was excellent because it has places where people can file complaint and then I've had like you know made it really easy a form you fill out and it was so I was thinking about that already but that we could do that it won't be hard.

Senator Régine Biscoe Lee: Great, thank you so much I'm looking forward to that and I thank you for the time Mr. Chair Si Yu'os Ma'åse'.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you, Senator Lee sir Lee, Miss Murphy I don't think you're going to have any problem with the confirmation I just caught I'm just confident of that Miss Murphy you know I'm not going this is only a joke I'm not going to hold you for working as a chief staff for Senator Carlotta right okay because everything else surrounding it you were doing great okay and you got Miss Flores here backing you so, you know name.

Shannon J. Murphy: I won't let her know you said that.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: I said it was a joke okay so I cleared myself okay

Shannon J. Murphy: I'm only kidding.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: But I do look forward to the all five of you getting confirmed. I'm hoping for that okay I will be submitting up the committee report asking for that endorsement I always believe that most of the senators are probably watching on TV of what all the nominees are stating yeah and you know I did read about that you don't have to worry about anybody selling you a political fundraising ticket now could you be it once you confirm you can actually say I'm sorry you can't do it and it's okay but also with the PDN and all the media folks I understand that but if you do find like you mentioned there's some recommendations you want please the five of you get together write it up you'll probably send it to me or senator Lee or any of the senators but the sooner you get it to us the sooner we can introduce it and let's get this rolling the people of Guam has been waiting for this ethics commission.

Shannon J. Murphy: That's true.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: As soon as I got the nomination, I know miss Flores, J Robert said while if fast in five days we pushed it out trying to get you all confirmed as soon as possible let's get this on the road and get some accountability and some ethics issue so that you can also help the Civil Service when I hear some, all government employees we just wrap this all up real quick because I also oversee the Election Commission and so we can do a lot of changes okay and I do look for. Do you have anything you wanted to bring up I was going to be in the Commission, people have been emailing me calling they can't wait to start. They want to be first in the agenda I'm like wait a minute this is not be an epic I'm not sure well I don't know what the rules I mean does this well we have to figure out is can they make it complain about something that happened five years ago or is only in this administration or you know how did because all it says is from this day forward or does it like I'm just not sure how that's all going to work. One of the five of you come together your majority you need five to be able to present and move forward because there's total seven members missing two more but there's five of you the five you can start doing what you need to do okay but I didn't just want to make sure that everything is positive piece of legislation quite a while ago right I think that's what everybody was worried about it was a good written law.

Shannon J. Murphy: Yeah.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: And nobody wanted to tap that water.

Shannon J. Murphy: Yeah.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: We are going to be ready to do it we want to get this moving okay?

Shannon J. Murphy: Thank you

Jose “Pedo” Terlaje: I also want to add that to every confirmation hearing I always come out with this that you know I mentioned that I am the oldest one in this group out of the 15 so I'm not going to ask them to confirm you I'm going to tell them to confirm thank you.

Shannon J. Murphy: okay I like it.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: All right there is no one else to testify, there being none the committee will conclude this public hearing. The committee will continue to receive testimonies for the next few days I would only give no later than Thursday for all testimony for anyone on the island to submit please address your in testimony to the committee on General Government Operations, and Appropriation and Housing and submit it via email to senatorjoessanagustn@gmail.com. and to the folks, the people of Guam Si Yu’os Ma’åse’ for watching us today and thank you all for participating today and your today’s hearing. Hearing is now 3:10 and this public hearing is now ended, thank you.

The public hearing was adjourned at **3:10PM**.
