

Jayne Flores, Chair, Government Committee – Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce: Thank you, Senator. My name is Jayne Flores, and I'm here in my capacity as a board member of the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce, and I'm also here to read Ms. Pika Fejeran's testimony. She is owner of Pika's Café, she is also a member of the CLTC Board, I believe, and she is a member of the Women's Chamber also. I will begin by reading her testimony, because it's the order.

**Chairman Ridgell:** Thank you, Mrs. Flores. Allow me to recognize Senator Therese Terlaje. Thank you for joining us. Please continue now, Mrs. Flores with your testimony.

**Ms. Flores:** Thank you. I am representing the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce as a board member. [Written testimony presented orally.]

Chairman Ridgell: Thank you, Mrs. Flores. Mr. Hernandez.

Artemio "Ricky" Hernandez, Deputy Administrator – Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA): Håfa adai, Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee. My name is Ricky Hernandez, I'm the Deputy Administrator or Acting Administrator of the Guam Economic Development Authority. I'm reading read this on behalf or in addition to Mel Mendiola. This testimony is in support of the confirmation of Ms. Hutapea as a member of the Board of Directors of the Guam Economic Development Authority. I'll go ahead and begin just reading the testimony.

Chairman Ridgell: Thank you, Mr. Hernandez. Mrs. Camacho.

**Joann Camacho:** Thank you. My name is Joann Camacho, and I'm a friend of Siska's. [Written testimony presented orally.]

**Chairman Ridgell:** Thank you very much. If there's no one else who would like to testify, I'll go ahead and call up the nominee at this time. Good afternoon... please go ahead and just turn on the mic. Good afternoon, Ms. Hutapea, please go ahead and begin by introducing yourself for the record and then you may begin.

Siska S. Hutapea, Appointee – Board of Directors, Guam Economic Development Authority: Thank you, Senator Ridgell and Senator Biscoe Lee and Senator Terlaje. Good to see you here. My name is Siska Hutapea, and by profession I'm a real estate appraiser. I've been in Guam for 20 years, by next month—May 28, '99—that's when I moved from Jakarta to here with my husband. We actually honeymooned here in

August '98, and we never looked back. Guam is home. All of our five children are made of Indonesian ingredients, made in Guam.

When I look at what I can do to help in—this year—I was looking at Guam Economic Development Authority, and when I look at the mission of GEDA to develop a sound and sustainable economy through innovative programs that preserve and promote economic opportunities, local culture, and quality of life, it really resonates to me. And I think with my 20 years' experience in Guam real estate, my passion to empower people in business, people in general—and my passion for sustainable economy, I think I can I can give and contribute to the GEDA Board of Directors and help in—especially—in real estate aspect of things.

I did complete the revaluation of the island-wide for property tax so, I know a thing or two about Guam real estate. I'm very familiar and very passionate about it, and I think I can contribute to the Guam Economic Development Authority.

**Chairman Ridgell:** Thank you. Senator Lee, do you have any comments or questions?

Senator Régine Biscoe Lee: Thank you, Mr. Chair. Thank you very much, Ladies and Gentleman—Mr. Hernandez—for your testimony. And I think it helps to give us some additional understanding and information about Siska, about your background and your education and your community involvement. Certainly, I want to thank you very much for accepting the governor's nomination, and I think that your expertise and experience will really bring a much-needed—that kind of background to the GEDA Board. I think that's really important. We have some incredible people working at GEDA, and they've been working there, many of them, for years if not decades. And one of them is in the audience with us. You know, there are a lot of people at GEDA that know exactly what they're doing and what we need to do, and so, it's really going to take board members like you to help draw out those ideas and work with our administrator and deputy administrator to make sure that we are continuing in that... that green path for Guam.

A couple of the things that I wanted to just touch base with you on is—if you have—like, what your ideas are that you would want to bring to the Board? What are some of the things that you feel are the most—maybe, maybe a challenge or an opportunity for us to really engage in, if you were to be nominated to this Board?

**Ms. Hutapea:** I can see that GEDA is administrating land for Guam Land Trust Commission, and I think I can contribute as far as choosing within those land which are the highest and best use of those land and add to the income and put them into work, put them into its highest and best use and not just leave it on what should I say not being developed to its highest and best use. My knowledge in that matters could help and assist the GEDA staff to manage the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission or Guam Land Trust Commission land that's under their management, administration.

**Senator Lee:** Great. Thank you very much. An additional kind of tool that GEDA uses is their qualifying certificates. They hand out QCs to businesses or, you know, certain types of industry that we need to develop here on Guam, and they use that tool or they have

used that tool in the past. I wanted to kind of get your sense of our current QC program and if you have any suggestions on maybe changes that we might be able to make to those qualifying certificates.

**Ms. Hutapea:** In my life as an appraiser, I have appraised many hotels, and of course, I do see the impact of the QC in making the investment feasible and sound for the hotel owners. I've seen them in work in real life how those QCs help the feasibility of a project. I have yet to work together with the GEDA staff to know more on how we can use this QC program to really encourage development and increase interest in investing in Guam.

**Senator Lee:** Thank you. The administrator, Ms. Melanie Mendiola... in her statement on the record for your nomination, she cites your understanding of real estate and overall property valuation on Guam and as that experience being really essential as they embark on the governor's initiative to secure investors under the opportunity zone program. If you could, I would just want to give you an opportunity to speak a little bit about that.

**Ms. Hutapea:** Yes... so, the zone is a new concept that is being introduced to help areas to be able to develop and invite investor and give tax incentives to the investor. I have to be frank with you that I only read about these opportunity zones the past few months, but I will work with the GEDA staff on exploring this opportunity zones and how we can really apply it to go on and and make sure that it is really beneficial to Guam and not just a program that is introduced in the mainland but have no applicability in Guam. I would really love to explore this idea with the GEDA staff.

**Senator Lee:** Great. Thank you very much, and again Mr. Chair, thank you for the opportunity to speak with Ms. Hutapea and to get a little bit of more of a sense of your background. I do just want to make mention, I know that the Guam Women's Chamber and Mrs. Flores had mentioned your knowledge or expertise but also something that kind of jumped out at me is the principle decision-making that you bring to the table, and I just want to thank you so much for (again) accepting the governor's nomination for your integrity and the way that you raise your children and the way that you give back to our community. We are so grateful for that, and I'm just really glad that you've accepted the governor's nomination, and I look forward to supporting you.

Ms. Hutapea: Thank you, and if I may add, the principle decision-making comes with having five children. You got to decide; otherwise, life's not going to go well.

Chairman Ridgell: Thank you, Senator Lee. Senator Terlaje.

**Senator Therese M. Terlaje:** Thank you, Mr. Chair. Thank you. This is good, and thank you Jayne for your testimony and First Lady Joanne and GEDA. Thanks for the testimony and particularly thank you for accepting the nomination and your willingness to serve on this Board. You know it's voluntary, but I have no doubt from your work

experience and your experience with Guam in particular that you're going to be an asset to the Board and bring all that knowledge and business savvy, really, to the decision-making by this Board. I was glad in GEDA's testimony that they pointed out that in addition to Chamorro Land Trust and Ancestral Lands, GEDA assists them in finding the properties that are up for lease or for investment to make—to get value for that—and everybody's looking to GEDA for a better value. GEDA has to also get best value for its own properties, and I think that's the challenge at this point. We have to reassess them and make sure that that's what we're getting. I mean, if there's any way to readjust those... but also your experience with financing, I guess I wanted to know... GEDA is also our financial advisor for the government of Guam, and if you could just talk a little bit about that, what is your experience in financing, and what do you think you'd be able to add to the Board in that regard?

Ms. Hutapea: Probably, my most... what should I say? Prominent financing is to manage the finance of a household. You have a certain amount of money to spend, and you have to be able to make sure that you can use that certain income to fit your family. That's one thing. The next thing is when I opened my small business, I did make a business plan. I prepared for it. It took me a year before I decided. I have master degree in real estate. I have 13 years of experience, but I still have to do a business plan to make sure that I'm not just passionate about what I do, but I also can make it work. That's my second level of financing experience. I did go and sought for a credit line before I opened my business, and when I do that, as a woman, I only think, "Oh, I can just ask for credit line for fifty thousand," but then Governor Lou at the time, was the president of the bank and said why not one hundred thousand? "Yeah, why not?" And it gives me such a flexibility. I did not misuse it of course, but it gives me such empowerment, and I know how that credit line have empowered me as a small business owner. I could concentrate in doing what I do best which is appraising and not have to worry about, "Oh, where is the pay?" Because in my company—my company motto is, "We value." It's not just what we do, but it's also in valuing the staff. Even though I'm a small company, I have 401k, I have health insurance, I have Aflac, and I try to—if it's important for me, it's got to be important for my employee. Responsible managing of money, and then I'm also involved in obviously providing appraisal report for lenders, and I've seen various development during my 20 years here. I've seen various development from a \$200,000 housing to a hundred million dollar hotel projects. I've seen them all, and I've seen how certain lease terms are important to financing. If you only have five year lease term, you cannot bring it to the bank, because you need at least twenty-five to forty years to make return on your money. I do learn a lot from dealing with my clients and helping them. I also involve—many, many of my clients are also in addition to the local property owners, local developers. I also have investors from off-island that sought my advice on development on Guam, and they bring in another level of financing, off-island private equity fund pension fund, and in all of that, I learned that in what you do, you have to be able to make a plan. You have to be able to make a project feasible. You have to be able to anticipate risk associated with that, and all of that. You have to plan it. In December, I was also on the financial transition team, and I was assigned with Senator Toni Sanford, and I learned so much about government budget at the time, and I even learned that how big of a task it is for Department of Revenue and

Taxation and how with many more money, they could do whatever they can to earn money. I've evolved. I've learned a lot. I also, of course, put my money where my mouth is. I invest in real estate. I learned about financing in there, and so that's kind of my background regarding financing. I don't know if that answers your question.

Senator Terlaje: Yes, very much. But yes, I guess we are—I just want to stress I'm glad you are aware that yes, there's other things GEDA could do, right? They're looking to them to do that so, we're hoping for that. The changes to the Board are going to help in that regard, and more important than anything is getting value for the government of Guam. The best value that we can get in our investments, in our land use, and in everything, from our employees. So, good. But do you think that your business will be impacted or there will be any conflict with this service and the business that you're running?

**Ms. Hutapea:** Well, Guam is very small, Senator Terlaje. Every time I write my report I have to sign out that I have no personal interests in the property that I'm appraising. I, at this point, all I can say is I will disclose if there's any interest that will happen in the future, I mean, if you look for the best appraiser on island, no--not bragging, but I have the only database, and I've built it over 20 years. I will disclose it if there is such time that there is a conflict of interest.

**Senator Terlaje:** Thank you. Does GEDA currently—do you currently contract with GEDA?

Ms. Hutapea: Not at this moment.

**Senator Terlaje:** Thank you again for your service and your willingness to do this to contribute. I think it's going to be a good match. Thank you, Mr. Chair.

**Chairman Ridgell:** Thank you, Senator Terlaje. Mrs. Hutapea, you spoke a lot about the role of GEDA with administering properties and leases and things of that nature. Because of your background in appraisal and real estate, I'm wondering what is your vision for Guam's economy overall, as a whole and the development of Guam's economy? What's your vision for the future for Guam's economy?

Ms. Hutapea: I'm the founding member of Guam Woman's Chamber of Commerce and also I'm now on the Board of Directors of Guam Chamber of Commerce, and in all of this we do strategic planning and we do the mission. What is our vision and mission for our organization? It all relates to again and again and again, a sustainable economic development. To me, sustainability is a matter of self-interest.

We have to be thinking about it; otherwise, we only have one earth to live. It's also very beneficial for example, as an appraiser. I could see when a hotel replaces its chiller, it costs them \$1.8 million for example. But they replace it to more energy-efficient—their payback is like in 18 months just because of the saving in the power that they spend. It's a matter of self-interest; it's good for you, but it's also good for the community to develop a sustainable economy.

Going back to your question... I grew up—I was born and raised in North Sumatra which is just across this Malacca Strait from Singapore, and I can't help but think... Singapore was independent in 1965. They become from third world economy -- they can become the first world economy. We have the same size, we have the same strategic location, we have the culture, and we we can be like Singapore on a different level. Not necessarily the same like Singapore, but we have that strategic location, and I always think that there's so much more that Guam can do for the economic development. I'm not saying that I can accomplish all of this by myself, but I have that vision about Guam, that we can be the leading—the Secretary of Interior representative came to meet with the Guam Chamber of Commerce, and they asked us, "What do you see Guam?" We told them that Guam could be the New York of Micronesia, the hub of financial, the hub of everything that is good.

That's, in short, my vision on Guam. And when you dream, dream big, right?

**Chairman Ridgell:** Absolutely. Thank you. I'm very happy to hear that you're thinking in those terms of Guam's future and how we can maximize our full potential here in this region. I'm very happy to hear that, and thank you for accepting the nomination. Congratulations for your nomination. I look forward to working with you in the near future, thank you.

# GEDA board nominee believes Guam's economy can grow

The owner of a successful real estate valuation company may be the newest addition to the Guam Economic Development Authority board of directors.

Siska Hutapea, Gov. Lou Leon Guerrero's nominee to the board, went before senators Tuesday for her confirmation hearing. GEDA officials and representatives from the island's business community spoke in favor of her confirmation.

Hutapea said GEDA's mission resonates with her and she is excited to work with the agency to find new ways to grow the economy.

"With my 20-year experience in Guam real estate, my passion to empower people in business, people in general, and my passion for a sustainable economy, I think I can give and contribute to the GEDA board of directors," Hutapea said.

Hutapea, who moved to Guam 20 years ago, worked in the real estate appraisal sector for years before breaking out on her own to build Cornerstone Valuation Guam. She holds a Bachelor of Science in civil engineering and a master's in real estate.

She is a founding member of the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce. Creating the organization required strategic planning, which always goes back to sustainable business practices, she said. Hutapea added that there's nothing keeping Guam from growing.

"I can't help but think that Singapore (grew) from (a) Third World economy; they have become a First World economy," she said. "We have the same size, we have the same strategic location, we have the same culture, and we can be like Singapore on a different level. ... There's so much more that Guam can do for our economic development. I'm not saying I can accomplish all of this by myself but I have that vision about Guam that we can be ... the New York of Micronesia – the hub of financial and the hub of everything that is good."

She told Sen. Clynt Ridgell, the committee chairman, who was joined by Sens. Therese Terlaje and Régine Biscoe Lee, that she plans to work with GEDA in exploring "opportunity zones" to see how they can benefit Guam.

Hutapea added that she would like to work with GEDA in using the qualifying certificate program to encourage development and increase interest in development on Guam.

Jayne Flores, representing the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce as a board member, testified that the body "wholeheartedly supports the nomination."

Flores said Hutapea will bring, a "well of knowledge, expertise and principled decision-making to the GEDA board of directors."

GEDA acting Deputy Administrator Ricky Hernandez read a statement from Chief Executive Officer Melanie Mendiola, who stated that the nominee's "extensive training and experience in real estate offers an opportunity for GEDA to more effectively manage the real property assets under its charge."

Former first lady Joanne Camacho testified before the committee and called Hutapea a "hard-working woman" and a "community leader."

Camacho said Hutapea is one of the "foremost experts in Guam's real estate sector who understands the issues facing Guam's real estate and the importance it plays in the overall growth of Guam's economy."

She testified that Hutapea would be a "tremendous asset" to the GEDA board of directors.
